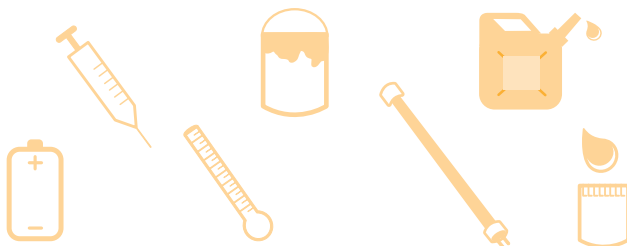

HOW DO I DISPOSE OF MY WASTE?

Make an Appointment (Required).

Call 858-694-7000 with your list of wastes. Appointments can be made Monday through Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Notify Customer Service if:

- Load is larger than 50 pounds.
- Containers are larger than 5 gallons.
- Containers are leaky or open.
- Product is unknown or unlabeled.

Bring Proof of City Residency.

Picture I.D. and a recent bill with your address.

Transport the Waste Safely.

- Bring only a total of five gallons or 50 pounds of wastes.
- Leave all products in original sealed containers.
- Place fuels (such as diesel, gasoline, contaminated oil) in a container that can be left behind.
- Place the wastes away from passengers (in the trunk or in the back of the vehicle).
- Keep waste separate from other items (such as trash or recyclable materials) for safe unloading.

WHEN IS THE FACILITY OPEN?

- OPEN SATURDAYS 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (Closed holiday weekends).

WHAT CAN I BRING?

Products used in the routine maintenance of your home, yard or vehicle including:

- Batteries (all types)
- Cleaning products
- Contaminated fuel (diesel, gas)
- Fluorescent light tubes/CFLs
- Paint waste
- Products labeled with words such as Danger, Warning, Caution, Poison, Flammable, Combustible or Corrosive.
- Used motor oil/used oil filters
- Used needles/sharps in a sealed sharps container.

NOTE: Empty paint cans, empty aerosol cans, and other empty containers may be placed in regular trash.



WHERE DO I BRING MY WASTE?

The Household Hazardous Waste Transfer Facility is located at the Miramar Landfill entrance on Convoy Street, just north of the 52-Freeway.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED?

- Ammunition, fireworks, marine flares
- Appliances (all types)
- Asbestos or lead paint wastes
- Business or commercial waste
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Electronics (all types)
- Medical or laboratory wastes
- PCBs and radioactive material

A recycle fee may be required. Always call ahead to verify if fees apply.
