







Only Clean Green Material Accepted

Clean material includes: leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, brush, tree trunks (without root balls), limbs and branches not exceeding six feet in length or two feet in diameter. Ice plant can only be accepted through curbside collection.

A load *must* be 90% clean green material. It may contain 10% non-green material with all contamination removed by the customer.

Clean green material excludes the following plants.

Clean Wood Scrap

includes:

Lumber, pallets, wood blocks, and clean construction wood for wood chips

excludes:

Chip board, particle board, and chemically treated or painted wood or shingles. For every 90% of clean wood scrap there may be up to 10% non-clean wood, but this must be removed by the customer at site.
