- Chip board, particle board
- Sod
- Chemically treated or painted wood
- All roofing shingles
- Rubber tree, Flax bush
- Bulb-type, and tropical plants

Only Clean Green Material Accepted

Clean material includes:

- Leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, brush
- Tree trunks (without root balls)
- Limbs and branches not exceeding six feet in length
- Pallets and clean construction wood
- Chipped palm fronds
- Lumber (unpainted and untreated)

*** A load **must** be 90% clean green material. It may contain 10% non-green material (pre-sorted, bagged and placed on top of load) with all contamination removed by the customer.
