SUBJECT: Removal of the West Miramar Landfill, Facility No. 37-AA-0020 from the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate State Minimum Standards

Dear Mr. Grealy:

Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff notified you in a letter dated, March 9, 2010, that the West Miramar Landfill was included on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate State Minimum Standards (Inventory), pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 44104. That action was a result of a repeat violation of the following State Minimum Standards (SMS):

- **Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20921 (a)(2) – Gas Monitoring and Control**

CalRecycle has since received the Local Enforcement Agency's (LEA) monthly inspection report for the month of February 2011 documenting correction of the above SMS. The LEA inspection report indicates that the violation has been corrected to the satisfaction of the LEA.

Therefore, the West Miramar Landfill is hereby removed from the Inventory. We appreciate your cooperation in correcting the above violation.

The LEA will continue to be responsible for inspecting the facility and providing written documentation (inspection reports) to CalRecycle regarding the compliance status of your facility. Please note that this action does not preclude any future notices or listings as a result of LEA documentation of SMS violations. Please continue to work with your LEA to maintain your facility in compliance with all applicable SMS.
