

Miramar Landfill REFUSE COLLECTOR BUSINESS TAX

- Effective Tuesday, November 1, 2005, the \$8-per-ton Refuse Collector Business Tax (RCBT) will be applied to all commercial and non-residential loads of refuse, regardless of weight.
- City of San Diego residents bringing loads of waste weighing two tons or more <u>will be charged</u> the standard RCBT.
- City of San Diego residents bringing loads of waste weighing less than two tons and generated from their primary residence will <u>not be charged</u> the RCBT. *Note: Proof of residency is required*.
- City of San Diego residents transporting loads of refuse or demolition material to the landfill for disposal will be asked to show proof of San Diego residency or origin of waste by providing such documentation as a receipt, a utility bill, or a driver's license.
- The RCBT was approved by the San Diego City Council on September 27, 1993 and supports the City's General Fund, which provides services such as police and fire protection, parks, street maintenance, and library operations.
- The RCBT will be included in the total charge for waste disposal.

- Persons who deposit refuse from a City-approved community cleanup campaign shall not pay the RCBT.
- The Miramar Landfill is the City of San Diego's only operating landfill.
