Applications for the City's 18th Annual Waste Reduction and Diversion Awards Program Are Available Now

San Diego, CA – Does your business or organization recycle? If so, you could win the City of San Diego's *Recycler of the Year Award* or the *Director's Recycling Award*. Each year, the City's Environmental Services Department (ESD) selects businesses and organizations located in the City that have implemented or expanded innovative and successful waste reduction, recycling and recycled product purchasing programs. The Recycler of the Year Award winners will be honored at a Special Event in April, 2010.

"After the City Recycling Ordinance went into effect in January, 2007, the efforts of our residents and businesses have resulted in San Diego reaching a 64% recycling diversion rate earlier this year," said Mayor Jerry Sanders. "We would like to recognize the companies and organizations that take the initiative and develop recycling and waste reduction programs because we see them as leaders that are setting an example for others to follow," he added.
