





The **“DARE TO REUSE”** art contest started out as an annual art exhibition for local found-object artists in the San Diego area. Past pieces have been some of the most creative and thought-provoking artwork in recent years. The exhibition eventually spread as an art contest to school aged children in 2011, with the online calendar being the first of its kind for the City of San Diego’s Environmental Services Department.
