

-  The tax files drop-off service is FREE to City of San Diego residents only.
-  All documents will be securely stored and shredded before being recycled.
-  Only residential tax files are accepted.
-  Businesses can find recycling services in the *Yellow Pages*, under "Business Records Destruction."
-  Consult a tax professional regarding how long tax documents are required to be kept on file.
