



What is yard waste contamination?

Gardening can be thirsty work, but what to do with that empty water bottle? The yard waste bin is right here. Why not just toss it in? And the dogs and cats have been doing their business again. The green bin is close at hand...why not just pop in the poop? Plant pots? Empty plastic bags? They're in the yard...must be yard waste...WRONG! Only plant material belongs in the yard waste bin.

Why clean greens matter:

Greenery contamination costs San Diego tax payers by way of lost resources.

Clean greens collected at the curb are intended for the Miramar Greenery where they are turned into compost, a valuable soil enhancing resource. Miramar compost is certified by the U.S. Compost Council, and this requires greenery that is free of contamination.

Turning yard waste into compost reduces environmentally harmful gases.

Contaminated greenery that is landfilled decomposes without oxygen, which produces methane gas, one of the most damaging of the greenhouse gases that contribute to global climate change.

How yard waste becomes resource:

Clean green waste goes to the Miramar Greenery to become compost, a valuable soil enhancement, that improves soil, saves water, and reduces the need for chemical fertilizers. Yard waste is ground in a grinder, spread into windrows, where it is turned and watered for 70 days and the temperature rises to between 135 and 163 degrees Fahrenheit to kill most weed seeds and all pathogens. The result is high quality compost available for sale at the Miramar Greenery at 5180 Convoy St., San Diego, adjacent to the City's Miramar Landfill.


