AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 00 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 26.16 RELATED TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE CITIZENS EQUAL OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION.

§ 26.16 Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission

- (b) Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission Established

There is hereby established a Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission which shall consist of ~~eleven~~ thirteen (13) members who shall serve without compensation. The Board shall include one (1) representative from each of the following minority groups: Latino, African-American, Filipino, American Indian, Asian/ Pacific Islander, Disabled, ~~and~~ Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender, Veterans, and Women. The remaining four (4) members shall be appointed from the City at large. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such manner that the terms of not more than six (6) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be January 1. During January of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall on or after February 15 select a Chairman from among its members. Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place becomes vacant. The Board shall adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary.
