**Item-9: Proposed Amendments to Ethics Commission Conflict of Interest Code.**

Executive Director Fulhorst explained that every two years the City Clerk’s office updates and forwards to the City Council for action, all changes to the conflict of interest codes. The proposed changes to the Commission’s code would add the Ethics Commission Financial Investigator as well as the anticipated Ethics Commission Attorney under Disclosure Category 1.

**Item-10: Proposed Revisions to the Election Campaign Control Ordinance (ECCO)**

Executive Director Fulhorst reported on the results of the Rules Committee action on the proposed ECCO amendments. She explained that the Rules Committee asked for the Commission's recommendation regarding a proposal to lift or adjust contribution limits for a candidate with an opponent who spends a large amount of personal wealth on a campaign.

By consensus, the Commission did not endorse such a proposal at this time.

Chairwoman Dorothy Smith adjourned the meeting to Closed Session at approximately 5:35 p.m. She stated if the Commission took any action that must be reported pursuant to the Brown Act, the Commission would reconvene into Open Session to report on that action.

2. The Commission ordered a Probable Cause Hearing and authorized the issuance of a Probable Cause Report and Draft Administrative Complaint in Case No. 2004-18, regarding Charles Ambers, Jr. and the alleged failure to file a Statement of Economic Interests.
