Description

Consistent with the City's Reserve Policy adopted by City Council, the Appropriated Reserve was established in Fiscal Year 2010 as a contingency for unanticipated, non-emergency needs that are identified during the year. The Appropriated Reserve may be used to alleviate unanticipated expenditures, revenue shortfalls due to an unexpected economic slowdown or recession, or to be used for one-time, high priority program/activities. The Reserve requires no maximum or minimum appropriated amount in any given year. However, the use of these funds would require an approval by a majority of the City Council. Funds that are not expended in a fiscal year will be returned to the General Fund's Unappropriated Reserve and may then be re-appropriated in the subsequent year.
