Group Description

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) group oversees all of the City's financial activities. The following departments report to the Chief Financial Officer: City Comptroller, City Treasurer, Debt Management, the Department of Information Technology, Enterprise Resource Planning, Financial Management, the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, and Risk Management.

The departments reporting to the Office of the Chief Financial Officer provide the following core financial functions for the City: managing the City's investments, collecting and tracking the City's revenues as part of the comprehensive City Treasury functions, maintaining the financial records for the City, developing the City's financial statements, developing debt financing proposals for borrowing funds, preparing annual budgets and long-range financial plans, providing strategic technology direction, and supporting the new enterprise resource planning system.
