SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Review Committee Referral Response

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This memorandum is in response to questions asked at the Review Committee Meeting held on May 6, 2014. The responses are listed by department in the order that they were reviewed by the Committee.

**CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 & 8**

**QUESTION:**

When will streets be resurfaced and what locations?

**RESPONSE:**

Street Segments identified for the Fiscal Year 2015 resurfacing projects are cross referenced with all other scheduled or proposed projects (i.e. group projects for Water and Sewer, and the San Diego Gas & Electric undergrounding program) in the IMCAT system prior to developing bid documents and advertising invitation to Bid. Construction typically begins approximately six months after funding is allocated to the Resurfacing Annual Allocation.

*Attachment 1* provides a list of tentative streets to be resurfaced.

**QUESTION:**

When will sidewalks be repaired and what locations?

**RESPONSE:**

Sidewalk repair and maintenance within the City is the responsibility of the adjacent property owner per Streets & Highways Code 5610-5618. Fiscal Year 2015 funding for sidewalk repair

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consists of \$400,000 in the Fiscal Year 2015 Proposed Budget, \$400,000 in additional funds included in the May Revise, and \$1.0 million is anticipated with the issuance of the third deferred capital bond, which totals \$1.8 million to repair sidewalks damaged by City trees. \$1.8 million will repair approximately 1,200 locations. Locations will be identified from the City's current tree tripping backlog. A list of the locations to be repaired will be available during the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2015.

### **COUNCIL DISTRICT 1**

#### **QUESTION:**

Provide a status update on the following projects: Alta La Jolla Drive Drainage, La Jolla Shores Lifeguard Station (a complete list of projects of interest will be provided).

#### **RESPONSE:**

*Attachment 2* provides an update on the status of the Alta La Jolla Drive Drainage Repair project. The project will be moving on a faster track since all the remaining activities in the project are within the City's control.

A status update on the La Jolla Shores Lifeguard Station is provided in the subsequent response.

Additional project status information will be compiled and the response will be forthcoming once the complete list of projects is provided by the Council District to the Financial Management Department.

#### **QUESTION:**

What is the original cost and the total cost of the La Jolla Shores Lifeguard Station project?

#### **RESPONSE:**

The original budgeted cost was \$3.4 million. It is currently being increased \$150,000 via Council Action (1472). However, as a result of the recent glazing changes and potential construction changes orders, litigation may be needed. It is difficult to estimate the cost for litigation activities.

### **COUNCIL DISTRICT 2**

Provide a status update on projects (list to be provided).

#### **RESPONSE:**

The information will be compiled and the response will be forthcoming once the list of projects is provided by the Council District to the Financial Management Department.

### **COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 & 7**

#### **QUESTION:**

Provide detail on skate park grant funding for the Linda Vista and City Heights projects.

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**RESPONSE:**

In January 2014, the Planning, Neighborhoods and Economic Department, in cooperation with the Park and Recreation Department, applied for the State of California's Housing Related Parks grant for the Linda Vista Skate Park and the City Heights Skate Park. The City expects to receive official notification of the grant award amount in June 2014. Based on that timeline, the Planning, Neighborhoods and Economic Department anticipates having a signed grant agreement in place by August 2014. According to the grant guidelines, the City will then have two years to complete the construction of both park projects. The purpose of the grant is to fully fund the planning, design, and construction of both the Linda Vista and City Heights Skate Park Projects. City staff will notify Council when the formal grant award amount has been received.

In addition to the Housing Related Parks grant, the Tony Hawk Foundation has awarded the City an \$80,000 grant for the skate park projects, \$40,000 for the Linda Vista Skate Park, and \$40,000 for the City Heights Skate Park. The City received the check from the Tony Hawk Foundation on April 9, 2014.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 4**

**QUESTION:**

Provide a status update on the following projects: MLK Jr. Promenade, Paradise Hills Library, Oak Park Library, Bay Terraces and Tooma Parks Senior Center, String Views Drive, Valencia Park Acquisition and Development improvements, South Chollas Landfill, Water pump station at Cielo Drive and Woodman St, Water jobs on University Avenue and Chollas Station Rd.

**RESPONSE:**

*Attachment 3* provides details on the projects listed above. *Attachment 4* provides more details on the South Chollas Landfill Improvement Project.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

**QUESTION:**

What will the additional \$800,000 in Barrio Logan Developer Impact Fee be used for?

**RESPONSE:**

The total developer impact fees for Barrio Logan Projects are \$1.9 million, which will be used to fund the following projects:

Traffic Signal: 32nd & Norman Scott Rd	\$ 300,000
ADA Improvements & Expansion to Chicano Park	\$ 250,000
ADA Improvements & Expansion of Paradise Senior Center	\$ 500,000
Fire Station #7	\$ 850,000

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

**QUESTION:**

Provide the projects that will replace the Otay Road Project on the CIP Cascade list.

**RESPONSE:**

The following are projects that will replace the Otay Road Project on the CIP Cascade list:

Resurfacing of City Streets/AID00005	\$5,000,000
New Walkways/AIK00001	\$3,000,000
Concrete Streets/AID00006	\$2,000,000

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 4**

**QUESTION:**

How many projects were requested versus approved by the Community Planning Committee?

**RESPONSE:**

378 total recommended projects were submitted by the Community Planning Committee (CPC). Of those, an analysis identified that 43 are included in current CIP projects (of which three may be duplicates), with 27 to be in a CIP within the next five years. Additionally, 42 run a likelihood of being created as funding and/or bundling opportunities arise. The responses to the CPC needs lists are currently being compiled and reviewed for distribution in the near future.

**PUBLIC WORKS**

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 & 8**

**QUESTION:**

When will DC3 Bond be issued?

**RESPONSE:**

The City Attorney's Office has indicated the trial date for the DC3 validation action will be scheduled by the court on June 13, 2014. If a favorable ruling is received by City, and staff is able to receive a go ahead from the bond counsel and the City Attorney, the bond offering process can be completed in two months from the date of the court ruling. If the City Council is in recess, a special session of the City Council is required to receive necessary approvals for the bond disclosure document.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

**QUESTION:**

Provide the list of projects that could be impacted with the delay of issuing the DC3 bond.

**RESPONSE:**

The Public Works-Engineering & Capital Projects Department is currently evaluating the list of capital projects which have been approved to receive funding from the next capital bond (DC3). A plan to fund the most critical projects with other funding sources is anticipated to be presented to the Infrastructure Committee in June 2014.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 & 3**

**QUESTION:**

Provide an update on the wet-signature process. The City Attorney's Office is working on developing the procedure on how to electronically create the equivalent version of the analog contracting practice. What is the timeline for this to be done?

**RESPONSE:**

The City Attorney's Office is working with staff on a change in the Muni Code per *Attachment 5*, which provides the Attorney's legal opinion on the wet-signature process. The Muni Code change will authorize the practice, but City staff will actually develop the procedure, not the City Attorney's Office. The Muni Code change could be at City Council in a couple of months, but the timeline for actual implementation depends on the process that City staff wants to use.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 1**

**QUESTION:**

What is the cost/benefit analysis of the San Dieguito Joint Powers Authority?

**RESPONSE:**

There are several operational and maintenance issues outlined in the Mayor's letter dated May 2, 2014 (*Attachment 6*) regarding the proposed Joint Powers Authority agreement that needs to be resolved over the next several weeks. The Public Utilities Department staff will be working on this.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES**

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 1**

**QUESTION:**

In regards to the Performance measure: Average number of days to responds to and resolve customer-initiated service investigations, what steps is the department taking to improve this?

**RESPONSE:**

Changes were made in the work process that resulted in improved efficiency. These changes include the strategic use of meter reading staff and overtime to supplement field investigation resources during periods of peak workload. This has eliminated prior periodic backlogs in the investigation process. In addition, the initial implementation of Advanced Metering

Infrastructure (AMI) will provide highly granular, near real-time data that will eliminate the need for field investigations to address many customer questions and concerns. Finally, automation of work orders and customer notifications will reduce some of the manual data entry steps that currently exist, which will further improve this performance metric.

## **COUNCIL DISTRICT 5**

### **QUESTION:**

How many asphalt/concrete pipes breaks have there been?

### **RESPONSE:**

In calendar year 2013 there were a total of 90 water main breaks, of which 53 were asbestos cement (59%) and 19 were cast iron (21%). Through April 2014 there have been a total of 32 water main breaks, of which 15 were asbestos cement (47%) and 11 were cast iron (34%).

## **TRANSPORTATION AND STORM WATER**

## **COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

### **QUESTION:**

Can Market Street resurfacing be prioritized?

### **RESPONSE:**

Market Street from 1st Ave to Park Blvd is on the tentative street resurfacing list for Fiscal Year 2015.

## **COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

### **QUESTION:**

There were no vacant bike support personnel in the Financial Management Department's vacancy report; is it filled, will it be filled or will it not be filled?

### **RESPONSE:**

The Citywide Bike Program Coordinator position has been re-assigned back to planning and managing right-of-way maintenance in the Transportation and Storm Water Department - Street Division. A Senior Traffic Engineer in the Transportation and Storm Water Department - Transportation Engineering Operations Division continues to plan and implement the City of San Diego's Bicycle Master Plan and related bicycle initiatives.

### **QUESTION:**

In regards to sidewalk maintenance and the offsetting cost of lowering the outside contracts, how are we going to monitor going forward to ensure that this is a good swap of funds for sidewalk maintenance?

**RESPONSE:**

The funding offset for 14 positions will enhance pothole repair and larger asphalt repairs. It is anticipated that in-house mill and pave crews will double the amount of asphalt repairs from 100,000 square feet to 200,000 square feet in fiscal year 2015. Cost per square foot for in-house mill and pave will be measured, monitored and reported at the end of the fiscal year.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 2**

**QUESTION:**

What is the estimated time of completion for the Talbot Street project?

**RESPONSE:**

*Attachment 7* provides the status of the Talbot Street Slope Restoration Project.

**COUNCIL DISTRICT 8**

**QUESTION:**

Provide a list of storm drain priorities.

**RESPONSE:**

The following list covers high priority areas where the storm drain is extremely deteriorated and areas where complaints have been received. While Corrugated Metal Pipes (CMP) storm drains are high risk, only these two categories are included. The average cost per drain replacement is \$1 million, though efficiencies are obtained by grouping projects.

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The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update on the status of the Alta La Jolla Drive Drainage Repair Project, Phase II as requested at the City Council's budget hearing meeting on May 6, 2014.

Permits Status: Staff applied and secured all required permits for the project including:

- Site Development Permit (SDP)
- Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)
- Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB 401)
- United States Army Corp of Engineers (USACOE 404)
- California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW 1602 permit). This specific permit was delivered to the City in April, 2014.

Design and Specifications: The design is finished except to incorporate the items that were identified by the resources agencies as part of the environmental permitting process.

Permanent Easement Package:

The permanent easement plans are completed and will be recorded once the additional design work is finished.

Schedule and Timeline for the Work:

The estimated duration to complete the additional design work is approximately six (6) months. Currently we are processing a consultant amendment for this work, which will start once the amendment is executed and approved. The bid and award process will take approximately 4-6 months. Construction is estimated to take 6 months. The construction work will need to be coordinated with the breeding season in the project area to avoid any conflict with the permits.

The progress of the project execution has been largely controlled by factors beyond the control of the City's design team. Now the project will be moving on a faster track since all the remaining activities in the project are within the City's control.

SUBJECT: South Chollas Landfill Improvement Project (S00684) – Project Status

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The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update on the status of the South Chollas Landfill – Chollas Operations Yard improvement Project as requested by Councilmember Cole.

The Chollas Operations Yard, except for the buildings, is built over the South Chollas Landfill. The Landfill has been issued violations from the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) and the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for not maintaining adequate cover and proper drainage over the Landfill. Hence, this project is to correct these deficiencies throughout the Chollas Operations Yard.

A consultant has been retained by Environmental Services Department to design comprehensive grading, drainage and landfill gas upgrades to bring the area to regulatory conformance. A preliminary estimate brings the proposed project cost to \$11.4 million to complete. The RWQCB and the LEA have been provided the preliminary design and schedule of the project. The submittal to these regulatory agencies identified our goal to have the Contract Plans and Specifications out to bid for competitive procurement in September 2014 and for construction to commence by the end of calendar year 2014 or early 2015.

**SUBJECT:** Authorizing Electronic Signatures on City Contracts and Bid Submittals

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**INTRODUCTION**

The City is considering implementing a new software program that would allow for an electronic procurement process using electronic signatures. This Office has been asked to analyze whether the use of electronic signatures and the electronic submittal of bids and proposals is legally permissible. Since this request, the City has executed an agreement with a vendor to obtain an electronic procurement system, and City and vendor staff have had, and continue to have, ongoing meetings to determine and refine various aspects of the electronic procurement program and the proposed uses of the vendor's system. Since a representative of our Office has not been included at these meetings, and the City is still in the process of determining which functions and uses it will make of the system, this Office has not had the opportunity to identify and/or address all the legal issues we anticipate will arise in connection with this complex project. Thus, the issues identified here do not represent an exhaustive list. The analysis included below focuses solely on whether the use of electronic signatures and the electronic submittal of bids and proposals is legally permissible. However, we welcome the opportunity to participate in discussion of the various aspects of the system and are ready to provide legal assistance as you navigate through this process.

**QUESTIONS PRESENTED**

1. Can the City employ electronic signatures for City contracts?
2. Can the City allow bids and proposals to be electronically submitted?

## SHORT ANSWERS

1. The City may use electronic signatures for City contracts, with some exceptions, provided that the technology selected meets minimum security and authentication requirements under state law and so long as the transaction complies with all other applicable laws, including the San Diego Charter and San Diego Municipal Code.

2. The City cannot accept bid electronically when sealed bids or proposals are required, unless the City revises the San Diego Municipal Code, to provide for electronic submittals. Moreover, the technology and procedures adopted by the City must ensure that the bids or proposals remain sealed until the bid opening date/time and can be verified as authentic.

## ANALYSIS

### **I. THE UNIFORM ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS ACT ESTABLISHES THE GUIDELINES ON ELECTRONIC RECORDS AND SIGNATURES FOR PUBLIC ENTITIES IN CALIFORNIA**

The Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (UETA), codified at California Civil Code sections 1633.1 – 1633.7, provides rules and regulations for electronic transactions and the use of electronic signatures for records created, generated, sent, communicated, received or stored on or after January 1, 2000. Generally, the UETA applies to electronic records<sup>1</sup> and electronic signatures<sup>2</sup> relating to transactions undertaken in the course of conducting business, commercial, and governmental affairs. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.3. However, a few transactions involving consumer transactions with special or unique consumer protection concerns are excluded from the UETA. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.3(b)(3). These excluded transactions do not concern the City as they involve the sale of goods to consumers.

The UETA provides that “[i]f a law requires a signature, an electronic signature satisfies the law.” Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.7(d). Valid electronic records or signatures may not be denied legal effect merely because they are in electronic form. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.7(a). The legality of contracts also may not be denied merely because an electronic record was used in the contract formation. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.7(b). The intent is for electronic records and signatures to be treated similarly to written records and manual signatures. Therefore, as long as the transaction complies with all applicable laws, including the San Diego Charter (Charter) and San Diego Municipal Code, the validity of a contract may not be denied simply because it contains an electronic signature. Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.3(e), 1633.7.

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<sup>1</sup> UETA defines “electronic record” as “a record created, generated, sent, communicated, received or stored by electronic means,” and defines “record” as “information that is inscribed on a tangible medium or that is stored in an electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable form.” Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.2 (g) and (m).

<sup>2</sup> UETA defines “electronic signature” as an “electronic sound, symbol or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record.” Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.2(h).

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The UETA applies only to electronic transactions where each party has agreed to conduct the transaction electronically. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.5(b). The use or acceptance of an electronic signature is at the option of the parties involved in the transaction. Cal. Gov't. Code §16.5. Thus, neither a public entity nor any other party to a transaction is required to accept or use electronic signatures. Cal. Gov't Code §16.5(b). This statute requires the parties to "opt-in" when conducting transactions electronically. Moreover, consent must be given for each transaction<sup>3</sup> between the parties. *Id.*; Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.5(c). The agreement between the parties to conduct the transaction electronically may be determined from the context and surrounding circumstances, including the conduct of the parties. *Id.*

An electronic signature used in any written communication with a public entity would have the same force and effect as a manual signature if and only if it has all of the following features: it is unique to the person using it; it is capable of verification; it is under the sole control of the person using it; and it is protected against manipulation. Cal. Gov't Code § 16.5(a).

The software selected by the City must be capable of creating signatures that meet each of these features. In order to be valid, the digital signature must be created by a technology<sup>4</sup> that is accepted for use in California. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22001. The California Code of Regulations sections 22000-22005 provide for a list of acceptable technologies.<sup>5</sup>

Currently, the regulations allow public entities to choose one of two different technologies: Public Key<sup>6</sup> Cryptography (PKC) or Signature Dynamics<sup>7</sup>. Cal. Code Reg. title 2, § 22003. PKC includes an additional level of security, usually a certification from a third party vendor, to ensure the legality of the electronic signature. *Id.* at § 22003(a). Signature Dynamics is more time consuming as additional steps are required to allow for verification of the signature. *Id.* at

<sup>3</sup> The City of Los Angeles created a form in which the city would obtain the contractor's authorization and sole authority to submit documents electronically. The form states that a hard-copy of the "E-Signature Authorization" would be maintained on file along with the original wet signature. By signing the agreement, the contractor agreed to sign electronically, by using an established personal identification number, all documents requiring a signature with the City of Los Angeles. Currently, the City of Los Angeles has suspended its program of accepting electronic contract documents and signatures due to technical issues (the specific technical problems are unknown by this Office).

<sup>4</sup> "Technology means the computer hardware/and or software-based method or process used to create digital signatures." Cal Code Regs. title 2, § 22000(a)(6).

<sup>5</sup> The list of acceptable technologies is not to be confused with a list of acceptable vendors or vendor-specific applications.

<sup>6</sup> "Public key" means the key of a key pair used to verify a digital signature." Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(1)(J). "Key pair" means a private key and its corresponding public key in an asymmetric cryptosystem. The public key has the ability to verify a digital signature that the private key creates." Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(1)(F). "Asymmetric cryptosystem" is a computer algorithm or series of algorithms that utilize two different keys with the following characteristics: one key signs a given message; one key verifies a given message; and the keys have the property that, knowing one key, it is computationally infeasible to discover the other key." Cal Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(1)(C).

<sup>7</sup> "Signature Dynamics" means measuring the way a person writes his or her signature by hand on a flat surface and binding the measurements to a message through the use of cryptographic techniques." Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(1)(D).

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§ 22003(b). Both technologies are acceptable for use by public entities in California provided that the signatures are created in compliance with California Code of Regulations title 2, section 22003.

## **A. Public Key Cryptography**

### **1. Electronic Signature Must Be Unique**

An electronic signature must be unique to the person using it. Cal. Gov't Code §16.5(a). A public-key based electronic signature is considered unique to the person using it if: (i) the private key<sup>8</sup> used to create the signature is only known to the signer; (ii) the electronic signature runs through a one-way function, creating a message digest, encrypting the resulting message digest; (iii) the signer is capable of being issued a certificate certifying the signer controls the key; and (iv) it is infeasible to derive the private key from knowledge of the signer's public key. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(2). The software selected by the City should be capable of ensuring that the private key could not be derived from the signer's public key when electronically signing off on a City document.

### **2. Capable of Verification**

An electronic signature also must be capable of verification. Cal. Gov't Code § 16.5. A public-key based electronic signature is capable of verification if: (i) all parties can verify that the document was digitally signed by using the signer's public key to decrypt the message; and (ii) the certificate of authenticity, if any is required, indicates how the signer's identity was verified. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(3).

A certificate of authenticity is defined as "a computer-based record which: (i) identifies the certification authority issuing it; (ii) names or identifies its subscriber; (iii) contains the subscriber's public key; (iv) is digitally signed by the certification authority issuing it or amending it; and (v) conforms to widely-used industry standards." Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(1)(D). Public entities may accept signatures with digital certificates issued by private vendors. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22005. However, the certification authority must appear on the approved list maintained by the California Secretary of State. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(6). The City may only accept certificates from vendors that appear on the approved list. *Id.*

### **3. Under Sole Control of Signer**

Whether an electronic signature is accompanied by a certificate or not, the person who holds the key used to create the signature or the party identified in the certificate assumes a duty to exercise reasonable care to retain control of the private key and prevent its disclosure. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(4). The law presumes that a party will exercise reasonable care in abiding by the statutes and regulations on electronic signatures. Cal. Evid. Code § 669.

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<sup>8</sup> "Private key" is the key of a key pair used to create a digital signature. Cal Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(a)(1)(H).

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An electronic record or signature is attributable to a person if it actually was the act of the person. Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.9. Whether an electronic signature is the act of a person may be proved in any manner, including a showing of the efficacy of any security procedure. *Id.* The UETA defines a security procedure as “a procedure employed for the purpose of verifying that an electronic signature, record, or performance is that of a specific person or for detecting changes or errors in the information in an electronic record. The term includes a procedure that requires the use of algorithms or other codes, identifying words or numbers, encryption, or callback or other acknowledgment procedures.” Cal. Civ. Code § 1633.2(n). Which types of security procedures might satisfy this requirement is unclear because neither the UETA nor the implementing regulations provide any guidance as to what may be considered effective. Due to the uncertainty surrounding attribution, many questions remain as to how the City may verify that an electronic signature was created by an authorized person.

#### **4. Protected Against Manipulation**

The electronic signature must be linked to the document in such a way that, if there are any unauthorized changes, the electronic signature and the document is invalidated. Cal. Code Regs title 2, § 22003(a)(5). If the parties agree to a security procedure detecting unauthorized changes, then the effect of the change or error may be avoided. Civ. Code §1633.10. The digital software that the City utilizes would need to include a component that invalidates the document if there is any unrecognized change to the document.

#### **B. Signature Dynamics**

The City also may employ Signature Dynamics, another acceptable digital technology recognized and utilized in California, provided that the signatures are created in compliance with California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 22003(b). Signatures using signature dynamics technology require additional hardware to create the signatures. *Id.* To be valid and acceptable, a Signature Dynamics signature must meet all four of the requirements discussed for PKC, but may satisfy them in a different manner.

##### **1. Electronic Signature Must Be Unique**

A signature produced by Signature Dynamics technology may be considered unique if: (i) the signature digest records the handwriting measurements of the person signing the documents using signature dynamics technology; (ii) the signature digest is cryptographically bound to the handwriting measurements; and (iii) after the signature digest has been bound to the handwriting measurements, it is computationally infeasible to separate the handwriting measurements and bind them to a different signature digest. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(2). The uniqueness of the electronic signature is generally determined by a lay-comparison of the manual signatures. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(3).

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## **2. Capable of Verification**

In contrast to PKC technology, a Signature Dynamics based electronic signature requires additional steps to verify the signer of a document. The signature is capable of verification if the acceptor of the digitally signed message obtains the handwriting measurements for purposes of comparison; and if the signature verification is a required component of a transaction with a public entity, the handwriting measurements can allow an expert handwriting and document examiner to assess the authenticity of the signature. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(3). An "expert" is defined as a person with demonstrable skill and knowledge based on training and experience. Cal. Evid. Code §720. Although Signature Dynamics requires the lengthy process of handwriting analysis to achieve certain verification of a signature, this technology is still capable of verification in compliance with Government Code section 16.5.

## **3. Under Sole Control of Signer**

A signature produced by Signature Dynamics technology is under the sole control of the person creating it if: the signature digest captures the handwriting measurements and cryptographically binds them to the message directed by the signer and to no other message; and the signature digest makes it computationally infeasible for the handwriting measurements to be bound to any other message. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(4). Verification of the electronic signature may be obtained by a lay-comparison of manual handwritten signatures, which may already be on file with the City.

## **4. Protected Against Manipulation**

The signature produced by signature dynamics technology must be linked to the message in such a way that if the data in the message are changed, the signature is invalidated. Cal. Code Regs. title 2, § 22003(b)(5). Signature Dynamics signatures are easier for the average user to understand, but do not provide the level of security inherent in PKC signatures because the signature is not immediately verified by a third-party issued certificate of authenticity.

## **II. BID SUBMITTALS**

Currently when sealed bids or proposals are required, the City accepts only paper bids. An original "wet" signature must be included with the sealed bid as the signature provides verification that the person signing the bid has authority to enter into the formal contract with the City. Sealed bids are submitted in sealed envelopes which remain unopened until the date/time of the scheduled bid opening at a public meeting.

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The City must use competitive sealed<sup>9</sup> bids for certain contracts. See Charter §§ 35 and 94; SDMC §§ 22.3203(d) and (e), 22.0902(e), 22.3004(b) and 22.3103.<sup>10</sup> The purpose of a competitive bidding process is to avoid favoritism, corruption, fraud, and waste of public funds, as well as to obtain the best economic result for the City. *Associated Builders & Contractors v. Contra Costa Water Dist.*, 37 Cal.App.4th 466, 469-470 (1995); *M & B Const. v. Yuba County Water Agency*, 68 Cal.App.4th 1353, 1360 (1999). These objectives are achieved by maintaining the confidentiality of submitted bids and requiring that all bids be opened at a specified time and considered simultaneously. Thus, all bids must be opened together (SDMC § 22.3011(b)(1)), at a public event, in front of witnesses (SDMC § 22.3011(b)(3) and (4)). The secrecy of submitted bids precludes any possibility of collusion or fraud.

The City's competitive bidding requirements are governed solely by the Charter and San Diego Municipal Code. As a charter city, the City is not subject to the state contracting code. *Domar Electric Inc. v. City of Los Angeles*, 9 Cal 4th 161, 170-171 (1994). The San Diego Municipal Code provides that "[i]nvitations to bid shall indicate the date, time, and location where bids will be opened." SDMC § 22.3011(a). "All bids will be opened at, or immediately after, the time noticed for the bid opening." SDMC § 22.3011(b)(1). In addition to the City employee opening the bids, a member of the public or at least one other City employee must also be present. SDMC § 22.3011(b)(3). "Bids will be unsealed and opened in the presence of those attending." SDMC § 22.3011(b)(4).

However, the City may, in its discretion, and when in the best interests of the City, follow portions of the California Public Contract Code. SDMC § 22.3002(b). Pursuant to California Public Contract Code section 1601(a)(1), a public entity may adopt an ordinance to receive bids on public works or other contracts electronically, provided that the bids cannot be opened before the bid deadline and all bids can be verified as authentic. If a public entity allows documents to be electronically submitted, an electronic receipt must be provided to the contractor showing the date and time the submission was received. *Id.* at § 1601(b). Additionally, the electronic procurement system would receive bids electronically and assign a pin number to the bidder to use in lieu of an original "wet" signature.

If the City desires to adopt the requirements of the California Public Contract Code, the City must amend its Municipal Code in order to allow sealed bids to be submitted electronically. The requisite safeguards under California Public Contract Code section 1601(a)(1) must be included in any such ordinance, i.e., the City must ensure that bids cannot be opened before the bid deadline and all bids can be verified as authentic.

<sup>10</sup> This Office previously analyzed whether the City could accept a bid without a signature, and, more specifically, whether a faxed response to a formal bid would meet the City's sealed bid requirement. See Memorandum of Law ML-90-46 (April 4, 1990); Memorandum of Law ML-90-57 (May 11, 1990).

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### III. ADDITIONAL ISSUES

As briefly mentioned earlier in this memo, we anticipate a variety of legal issues will arise over the course of this project. In addition to the two legal issues analyzed here, our Office also has identified and communicated to you a number of other issues associated with an electronic procurement system that need further legal review and analysis. In particular, on various occasions our Office has advised various City staff that the City may or may not legally be able to utilize the full range of functions provided by an electronic procurement software program. We advised that there may be limitations as to the types of documents that can be submitted electronically, such as bid bonds, performance bonds, and insurance certificates. For example, copies of bonds may be submitted electronically but must be followed up with paper submittals and wet signatures. More information on how these documents are to be received and/or entered into the system is necessary before we can more fully address any potential issues. Further, we have advised that the City must still allow paper submissions for anyone that cannot use the electronic program. This would include those with limited access or no access to computer equipment, and those with ADA constraints. We also advised that the use of reverse auctions will require a municipal code amendment and a draft was submitted to the Department for review and edits. That review has not been finalized and the municipal code amendment still remains outstanding.

We cannot predict what additional issues may arise. However, based on what we know to date, a host of legal issues are likely to arise as this project evolves. Given the important and widespread impact of this project, it would be prudent to ensure the legal issues have been identified and analyzed in advance of system implementation. Accordingly, our Office previously has advised, and continues to advise, that the City delay the proposed "go live" date for implementation of the vendor software until we have had the opportunity to fully analyze and advise on any and all legal issues.

### CONCLUSION

The City may use electronic signatures for City contracts, with some exceptions, provided that the technology selected meets the minimum security and authentication requirements under state law and so long as the transaction complies with all other applicable laws, including the Charter and San Diego Municipal Code. The City cannot accept bids electronically when sealed bids or proposals are required, unless the City amends the San Diego Municipal Code to provide for electronic submittals and has in place technology and procedures that ensure the bids or proposals cannot be opened before the bid opening date/time and can be verified as authentic.

Dear Supervisor Roberts:

As a result of discussions during the April 17, 2014, meeting, I have directed City of San Diego (City) staff to include funding of \$254,000 in the City's Proposed FY 2015 Budget through the May Revision process to extend the current 1989 Joint Powers Authority (JPA) Agreement (Agreement) for up to one year beginning July 1, 2014. The proposed allocation will be considered by San Diego City Council as part of the adoption of the May Revise.

San Dieguito River Valley Regional Open Space Park (Park) is a valuable recreational asset to the San Diego region. It is important that the City and its partners provide visitors a quality, accessible experience while maintaining precious resources. At the end of any long-term agreement, it is prudent for the City to evaluate effectiveness and deliverables prior to engaging in another long-term contract that financially commits the City well into the future. It is in our collective best interest to ensure the proposed term makes sense for taxpayers in all jurisdictions participating in the JPA.

Over the course of the year, the City's objective is to work cooperatively with the JPA to alleviate the following concerns within the draft Agreement:

- **Non-Weighted Voting:** Two of the nine JPA members are represented by the City, comprising approximately 22% of the vote. The City requests a weighted vote to reflect the City's percentage financial contribution (31%) in the proposed agreement. Alternatively, the City's proposed contribution could reflect the percentage of park users rather than total land and citywide population.
- The Agreement needs to include adequate language that does not compromise the City's right to retain full management authority of its land within the Focused Planning Area.

It is my hope to embark on a new era of cooperation and confidence in the management of the Park, ultimately for the enjoyment all San Diegans.

Project Status: In construction


- NTP (Notice to Proceed) with construction was issued on 9/16/13
- Percent Completed to date: 30%
- Expected Date of Construction Completion: July 2014

Schedule and Timeline for the Work:

The duration of the construction is 161 days. The current completion date is July 2014 and we are currently at 30% completion. This project did go through some design changes during construction due to unforeseen site conditions and largely controlled by factors beyond the control of the City's design/construction management team. Staff, our design consultants and our team have worked through these challenges to provide solutions. This also caused our schedule to push back completion of this project by approximately 2 months.

This project is fully funded by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). Therefore, the additional work will not require any additional local funding money.
