Description: This annual allocation provides for capital improvements at Brown Field. The improvements are financed by the Airports Enterprise Fund, which may receive State and federal grants. Individual projects are recommended to the City Council based on the Master Plan for the airport and on the availability of funding. These improvements will not be impacted by the Brown Field Development Project.

Justification: This project may be used to provide matching local funds for capital improvement projects, which are supported by State and federal grants that require local financial participation, and to provide permanent public improvements for which no State and federal grant funding is available.

Operating Budget Effect: None.

Relationship to General and Community Plans: This project is consistent with the Otay Mesa Community Plan and is in conformance with the City's General Plan.

Scheduling: Projects will be scheduled on a priority basis.

Summary of Project Changes: The annual project cost for Fiscal Year 2010 is \$850,000 to fund two new projects. They are Brown Field Airport Rehabilitation Design of Taxiway Bravo and Taxiway Charlie; and Brown Field Airport Runway 8L/26R, Runway 8R/26L and Taxiway Alpha Design.

They are Montgomery Field Airport Northwest Heliport, Montgomery Field Airport Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation Construction, and Montgomery Field Airport Rehabilitation Design of Runway 5/23 and Taxiway Golf.
