

Montgomery Middle School, Eighth Grade, N=216¹

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 45% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 44% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe
- **Question #5** Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 51% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all
- **Question #6** 61% reported that there were gang members at their school
- **Question #7** 73% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school

Questions 8 -13

- 59% witnessed fights
- 45% witnessed graffiti or tagging
- 33% witnessed others with weapons
- 27% witnessed drug transactions
- 25% witnessed others being robbed

Questions 14 - 19

- **Streets/Neighborhoods/Alleys – 29%**
- **Fast Food restaurants, Stores, Mall – 14%**
- **Bus stops – 11%**

Top things that would make them feel safer:

Question #21

- **Someone to walk with/more people around, Get a ride, bike – 28%**
- **Law Enforcement - 17%**
- **Adults/Parents supervision – 7%**

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 45% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe
- **Question #5** Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 40% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all
- **Question #6** 52% reported that there were gang members at their school
- **Question #7** 61% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school

- Someone to walk with/more people around – 22%
- Law Enforcement - 19%
- Get ride, bus, bike etc. – 17%
- Parental/Teacher supervision – 8%

Gompers Middle School, Ninth Grade, N=34¹

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 32% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe
- **Question #5** Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 44% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all
- **Question #6** 59% reported that there were gang members at their school
- **Question #7** 71% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school

Students often witnessed crime to and from school

Questions 8 - 13

- 62% witnessed fights
- 62% witnessed graffiti or tagging
- 47% witnessed others with weapons
- 44% witnessed drug transactions
- 35% witnessed others being robbed
- 35% witnessed a shooting, stabbing or beating

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 31% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe
- **Question #5** Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 42% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all
- **Question #6** 57% reported that there were gang members at their school
- **Question #7** 70% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school

- 55% witnessed graffiti or tagging
- 45% witnessed others with weapons
- 26% witnessed drug transactions

- Get a ride, bus, car – 11%
- Someone to walk with/more people around – 10%

- **Question #3** Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 44% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe
- **Question #5** Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 50% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all
- **Question #6** 60% reported that there were gang members at their school
- **Question #7** 74% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school

Students often witnessed crime to and from school

Questions 8 - 13

- 68% witnessed fights
- 51% witnessed graffiti or tagging
- 37% witnessed others with weapons
- 36% witnessed drug transactions
- 28% witnessed others being robbed
- 28% witnessed a shooting, stabbing or beating

Questions 14 - 19

- 33% were in a physical fight between groups of kids or jumped
- 28% were physically hurt or threatened
- 18% were robbed
- 15% were harassed for recruitment by a gang member
- 14% were threatened with a weapon

- Parks – 53%
- Bus stops/Trolley Stations – 26%
- Fast Food restaurants/Stores/Businesses – 12%

- Get a ride, School Bus – 38%
- Someone to walk with/more people around – 31%

- **Question # 3 - Of those who walked or rode the bus TO school, 41% felt either somewhat unsafe or not at all safe**
- **Question #5 -Of those who walk or ride a bus FROM school, 46% felt either somewhat unsafe or not safe at all**
- **Question # 6 - 44% reported that there were gang members at their school**
- **Question #7 - 71% reported that there gang members in the neighborhoods near their school**

Students often witnessed crime to and from school

Questions 8 - 13

- **73% witnessed fights**
- **59% witnessed graffiti or tagging**
- **32.7% witnessed drug transactions**
- **29% witnessed others with weapons**
- **27% witnessed others being robbed**
- **22% witnessed a shooting, stabbing or beating**

Students were victimized by crime to and from school

Questions 14 - 19

- **32% were physically hurt or threatened**
- **37% were in a physical fight between groups of kids or jumped**
- **24% were harassed for recruitment by a gang member**
- **20% were threatened with a weapon**
- **17% were robbed**

Top unsafe/dangerous places around school:

Question # 20

- **Streets/Neighborhoods/Alleys – 63%**
- **Parks – 56%**
- **Bus stops/Trolleys – 32%**
- **Gas Station/Stores – 20%**
