What is CalGRIP?

- California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention
- First CalGRIP grant was from 2008-2010
- Collaborative Partners: SD Police Department, SD Commission on Gang Prevention & Intervention, SD Park and Recreation, METRO United, SD County Health and Human Services Agency and SANDAG
- Three-pronged Approach: Prevention, Intervention, and Suppression





Prevention

- 4,666 visits to the recreation centers from May to September 2011
 - 17% at Memorial, 25% at Encanto,
 - 26% Southcrest, 32% Mid-City
- Average age of youth was 12 years and in 7th grade
- Three out of five were males (61%)
- Activities included:
 - Sports
 - Movie nights
 - Arts and crafts
 - Community barbeques





Majority of Youth Had Positive Perceptions of Police in their Community

Police in my community	Agree	Disagree
Are here to protect people like me	91%	10%
Respect people like me	87%	13%
Overall, do a good job of stopping crime	82%	18%
Total	196-201

Intervention Activities

- Targeted gang exposed and gang involved youth
- Partnership between police and CBO (i.e., SDPD and METRO)
- Provided mentorship and referrals to support services including:
 - Academic assistance, employment support, mental health, substance abuse treatment, and wrap-around services.





Intervention Participants at Intake

- METRO completed intakes with 23 youth since August 2011
- All of the youth identified themselves as gang exposed
- 7 youth reported gang involvement
- 20 youth made an appointment with different programs and received services





SDPD Intervention Activities

- Currently working with 12 youth
 - School follow-ups
 - Gang problems
 - Involvement with recreation centers
 - Probation interaction
 - Gang prevention presentations





Suppression Activities

- Officers target gangs and gang members in areas impacted by the grant
- Gang Intervention Officer identified and referred at-risk youth to METRO for services
- Officers provided patrol support at the four recreation centers during extended hours
