5. Action Agenda:

Item A-

The Safe School Zone Ad Hoc Committee has researched the use of signage that calls attention to state and federal laws enhance the penalties of crimes committed within 1,000 ft of a school. (**Goal #3:** *Advocate, formulate, and recommend for adoption proactive gang policies, ordinances and guidelines*)

Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the Commission on Gang Prevention and Intervention support efforts by San Diego Unified School District (San Diego Unified School Police) to build a community awareness campaign using the existing signs and the updated signs as well as make a recommendation to the Mayor and City Council to participate in the campaign.

Item B-

Every two years the Commission has co-sponsored a Community Summit. Discussions have begun with USD regarding its 4th summit slated to happen early 2014. A Community Summit Ad hoc Committee would facilitate the planning and organizing of the event. (**Goal #2:** *Make policy recommendations to the Mayor and City Council on issues of gang prevention, intervention, diversion and suppression methods, identify local, state and federal funding sources, and identify best practice efforts*)

Recommended Action:

Establish the Community Summit Ad Hoc Committee.

Item C-

The Commission co-sponsored a Community Trauma symposium in October 2012. Since then Commissioners have spoken at various venues and written a white paper on trauma informed care. Commissioner Rosa Ana Lozada and Commissioner Dana Brown have spoken at USD. An Ad



Hoc Committee would help develop a web page on the Commission's website (per City guidelines) for community resources on trauma informed care (**Goal #3: Advocate, formulate, and recommend for adoption proactive gang policies, ordinances and guidelines**)

Recommended Action:

Establish an Ad Hoc Committee to create a library of resources on Trauma Informed Care and support the development of trauma informed schools by San Diego Unified School District by networking resources and providing linkages to training.

Item D-

A focus group of Commissioners have been participating in a survey designed by the California Endowment. The survey is to assess the collaborative work of the Commission. So far there is high satisfaction for the Commission work and Commissioners understand clearly its focus and responsibilities. This is the focus under Goal #3 – #3.1 *Collaborative accountability*. In order to get everyone's input staff will be creating a survey monkey and an ad hoc would help write the final report for September presentation.

Recommended Action:

Establish an Ad Hoc committee to work with staff on finalizing the survey and report in September on the results.
