Attached is the survey that Commissioners will be taking to the city- wide community meetings for resident input.. An Ad Hoc Committee would be helpful in reviewing and commenting on the to be data gathered and a review/comparison of what other cities are doing to impact gang violence to help the Commission make recommendations. Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the Commission on Gang Prevention and Intervention establish an Ad Hoc Committee to review the data, investigate other initiatives, research other cities efforts to address the impact of gang violence and provide a report to the Mayor and City Council about recommended next steps.

Item B-

The Commission has been working in the community to address graffiti issues. The community is in need of a more coordinated effort to inform them of available resources to address graffiti. The goal is to identify existing efforts and to create a document that could be posted on the Commission website and distributed to the community.
