The influence of streets gangs, narcotics, and alcohol continues to plague the youth of our city. However, there are many positive alternatives. Your involvement as a parent can be the single most important factor in eliminating these negative influences in the life of your child. I invite you to contact the officer listed below to discuss these issues. The officer will also have information on available referral programs in your area.
