### HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR CITY OFFICES AND SERVICES

**THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2010**

**THANKSGIVING DAY**

#### **Public Safety:**

- Police and Fire emergency crews will not be impacted.
- Station 38 (citywide emergency dispatch center) will be on duty.

#### **Other:**

- There will be a one-day delay in trash, yard waste, and curbside recyclables collection for customers served by the Environmental Services Department beginning Thursday, November 25, 2010 due to the Thanksgiving Day holiday. For example, Thursday's collection will occur on Friday, and Friday's collection will occur on Saturday.
- Trash and recyclables collection will return to its normal schedule Monday, November 29, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Landfill will be closed on Thanksgiving Day. The Landfill will return to its normal operating schedule, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Friday, November 26, 2010.
- The City's "refuse/recyclables" container sales office on Miramar Place will be closed on Thursday and Friday, November 25-26, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Household Hazardous Waste facility will be closed on Saturday, November 27, 2010. The facility will resume operations on Saturday, December 4, 2010.
- This holiday information for trash and recyclables collection is for the City of San Diego only. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.
- Golf courses will be open until 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 25, 2010; holiday rates will apply. Golf courses and starter booths will be open for their normal business hours on Friday, November 26, 2010 and normal rates will apply at Balboa and Mission Bay Golf Courses. Weekend rates will apply at Torrey Pines. The Golf Administration Office at Torrey Pines will be closed on Friday, November 26, 2010.

- Balboa Park will be open. All public buildings and museums in Balboa Park will be closed with the exception of the Reuben H. Fleet Science Center, which will be open from 10:00 to 5:00, and the San Diego Zoo, which will be open from 9:00 to 5:00 on Thursday, November 25, 2010.

### **Specific Closures within the City of San Diego:**

- All Administrative Offices will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- The Testing, Employment Information Center and Background/Fingerprinting offices within the Personnel Department will also be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- The Office of the City Treasurer will be closed Thursday, November 25, 2010 and Friday, November 26, 2010. There will be alternate locations open on Friday, November 26, 2010 to accept payments for delinquent bills, parking citations, and water bills.
- Open Space and Maintenance Assessment District Offices will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- Tecolote Nature Center will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- Mission Trails Regional Park Visitor Center will be closed Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- Chollas Lake will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- All City recreation centers will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- All City pools will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010 and open on a holiday schedule on Friday, November 26, 2010. Please contact the pool site for specific hours of operation.
- Robb Field Skate Park (Ocean Beach), Rancho Peñasquitos Skate Park, Carmel Valley Skate Park, Bill and Maxine Wilson Skate Park (702 South 30th St.), and the Charles L. Lewis III Memorial Skate Park (6610 Potomac St.) will be open on Thursday, November 25, 2010.
- All libraries will be closed on Thursday, November 25, 2010. A special schedule has been set for the City libraries for the remainder of the Thanksgiving weekend.
- Parking meters, time restrictions on parking on streets and yellow zones within the City of San Diego will not be in force. Red and white zones are still enforced on holidays. Parking rules on Port property and in different cities may vary so please read signage provided.
