




EVALUATION OF CITY IN SELECTED AREAS




ATTITUDE ABOUT HOW ESSENTIAL SELECTED CITY SERVICES ARE




SATISFACTION WITH CITY SERVICES --TOP RATED




SATISFACTION WITH CITY SERVICES -OTHER SERVICES




PRIORITY SPENDING INDEX -TOP PRIORITIES




PRIORITY SPENDING INDEX -- OTHER PRIORITIES




REACTION TO SELECT STRATEGIES TO DEAL WITH BUDGET DEFICIT





QUALITY OF LIFE IN SAN DIEGO




LIKELIHOOD OF TAKING SELECTED STEPS


