Fiscal Year 2016 Proposed Budget May Revise General Fund Highlights

Major Revenue Growth: \$5.2M User Fee Adjustments: \$900K

Department Revenue, Streamlining and Other Adjustments: \$1.5M

Total Ongoing Resources: \$7.6M **Total One-time Resources:** \$800K

Total Resources: \$8.4M

Safe and Livable Neighborhoods

- \$1.2M to expand from 45 to 60 the weekly operating hours at 20 recreation centers throughout the City
- \$210K for library materials
- \$130K for a park manager to provide better service at Balboa Park and Mission Bay Park
- \$75K for a horticulturist to review landscaping and irrigation needs throughout the entire parks system and help with water conservation goals
- \$50K to fund the San Diego State study on the Police Department's stop data cards
- \$80K to hire a grant-funded Active Transportation Planner

Infrastructure Investments

- \$100K for an interim off-lease dog park at Ward Canyon Park
- \$1.7M to improve existing Park and Recreation and Library facilities

Excellent Customer Service and Open Government

- \$100K to enhance the open data initiatives and online budget tool
- \$140K to speed up the City's hiring process by providing online hiring support and expedited background checks

Technical Adjustments

- \$1.8M for election costs
- \$400K for City Council-approved mandated sick leave for hourly employees (\$471K Citywide)

Fiscally Responsible Management

- \$15M in savings from current fiscal year budget to create Pension Stabilization Reserve Fund
- \$6.7M in savings to fully fund the Public Liability reserve target of 47%
