SUBJECT: Nominations for the Human Relations Commission

I am seeking nominations for the Human Relations Commission.

Under Article 6 §26.0902 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the purpose and intent of the Human Relations Commission is to consult with and advise the Mayor and City Council on the rights of every inhabitant of the City of San Diego to equal economic, political, and educational opportunity, to equal accommodations in all business establishments in the City, and to equal service and protection by public agencies. The Commission shall give effect to such rights to eliminate prejudice and discrimination because of race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry, age, gender, sexual orientation, disability, medical condition, place of birth, citizenship, marital status, military service, or any other characteristic protected by applicable federal, state, or local laws, and shall advise the Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on methods to inform the inhabitants of the City of San Diego of developments in human relations.

Each council district may submit up to three names for consideration for appointment. I will appoint one member per council district from the pool of nominees provided by City Councilmembers. Each member should have a demonstrated expertise in human relations work and a commitment to fostering better human relations in the City of San Diego.

Please submit nominations by March 6, 2015.
