

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PERMIT FEE INCREASE

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2007

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO WILL CONSIDER ADOPTING A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INCREASES IN THE TRUCKER'S DISCHARGE PERMIT FEES FOR THE CITY WASTEWATER SYSTEM. TRUCKER'S DISCHARGE PERMIT FEES COVER THE EXPENSE OF PERMITTING, MONITORING, TREATING AND DISPOSING OF TRUCKED DOMESTIC AND INDUSTRIAL WASTES. THE PROPOSED INCREASES IN FEES ARE FROM \$25.00 PER YEAR PLUS \$5.00 (DOMESTIC) / \$10.00 (INDUSTRIAL) PER 1000 GALLONS OF WASTES TO \$25.00 PER YEAR PLUS A FEE BASED ON RATES APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO THEN IN EFFECT. BASED ON THE PROPOSED RATES UNDER CONSIDERATION THE NEW FEES WILL RANGE FROM \$15.00 TO \$100.00, OR MORE, PER 1000 GALLONS OF WASTE. FACTORS DETERMINING THE FEES ARE VOLUME, TOTAL SUSPENDED SOLIDS AND CHEMICAL OXYGEN DEMAND.

CONSIDERATION OF THE RESOLUTION WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED CITY COUNCIL MEETING TO BE HELD ON MONDAY FEBRUARY 26, 2007 AT 2:00 P.M. OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS BUSINESS ALLOWS, IN THE CITY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 12<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR, 202 C STREET, SAN DIEGO, CA, 92101. ANY INTERESTED PARTY MAY ATTEND THE MEETING AND MAKE AN ORAL OR WRITTEN PRESENTATION ON THE MATTER.

Data indicating the amount of cost, or estimated cost, required to provide the services for which the Trucker's Discharge Permit Fees are charged, and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the services, is available for public review in the Wastewater Cost of Service Study, which can be reviewed at the City Clerk's Office located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the City Administration Building, and on the City's website at [www.sandiego.gov/mwwd/pdf/ratestudy.pdf](http://www.sandiego.gov/mwwd/pdf/ratestudy.pdf).
