The City has completed the review of the application and determined that adequate data has been presented to approve Plastic Trends Inc. PVC sewer pipe fittings, which consists of Series G for SDR35 requirements, Series H for SDR26 requirements, Series C pressure sewer fittings for DR-18 Class C-900 or C-905 requirements.

The approval of these PVC sewer pipe fittings for use on the City wastewater system is effective as of the date of this letter and will be included in the next Wastewater Approved Materials List update.

The acceptance and approval of Plastic Trends Inc. PVC sewer pipe fittings are contingent on the following conditions:

1. Plastic Trends' PVC sewer pipe fitting products listed above are manufactured at Plastic Trends Incorporated, 56400 Mound Road, Shelby Township, MI 48315.
2. Plastic Trends shall be responsible for notifying the City in advance of any changes in the products, ownership or location of the manufacturing plant(s).
3. Plastic Trends shall provide installation procedures for the products to ensure the products meet the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook) and the City's Whitebook 2012. The installer shall meet the specification conditions


