Subject: Approval of Pamrex and Pamtight Manhole Covers and Frames for the Wastewater Approved Materials List

This letter is in response to your application in which your firm requested the City of San Diego (City) evaluate and approve the Pamrex and Pamtight Manhole Covers and Frames.

The City has completed the review of this application and determined that adequate data has been presented to approve the Pamrex and Pamtight Manhole Covers and Frames.

The approval of these products for use on the City of San Diego's wastewater system is effective as of the date of this letter and will be included in the next Wastewater Approved Materials List update.

The acceptance and approval of the Pamrex and Pamtight Manhole Cover and Frame products is contingent on the following conditions:

The manhole covers and frames shall have all ductile iron components manufactured and all products assembled by Saint Gobain Canalizacao LTDA, Rodovia MG 431, Itauna, MG 35680, Brazil.

- 1) Pam Saint Gobain or Pacific Pipeline Supply shall notify the City in advance of any changes in the products, ownership, or location of the manufacturing plants.
- 2) Pam Saint Gobain or Pacific Pipeline Supply shall provide application/installation procedures for the products to ensure the products meet the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook) and the most current edition of the City's Whitebook. The installer shall meet the specification conditions required for the proper installation of products as specified by Pam Saint Gobain, Pacific Pipeline Supply, or any of Pam Saint Gobain's authorized suppliers.

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
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- 3) Any unilateral action by Pam Saint Gobain or Pacific Pipeline Supply without prior consultation and agreement from the City regarding the above mentioned conditions and limitations shall constitute a breach of agreement resulting in the removal of Pamrex and Pamtight products from the City's Wastewater Approved Materials List.

Because these products are manufactured outside the United States of America, they may not be acceptable for use on projects involving state or federal funds where there is a "Buy American" requirement in the contract documents.

Congratulations on your success in being included on the City's Wastewater Approved Materials List.
