

DUMPSTER PERMIT INFORMATION FOR FIRE DAMAGED SITES

- A dumpster permit must first be obtained before placing a dumpster in the right-of-way. The permit fee is \$70.00 for a time period up to one month. This fee will be waived for properties within the fire affected areas.
- The dumpster permit can be obtained at Booth 22 on the 3rd floor of the Development Services Center at 1222 First Avenue, San Diego, or at the Rancho Bernardo Local Assistance Center.
- A dumpster may not be placed in front of painted curb such as passenger loading, or disabled zones.
- A minimum of 10' (feet) clearance is required from dumpster door to nearest obstruction.
A minimum of 25' (feet) clearance is required from dumpster door to alley or curb return.
- A dumpster shall be placed entirely in front of the requesting business or residence and shall not be placed in front of an adjacent business or residence.
- "No Parking" signs shall be posted 24 hours in advance of dumpster placement.
- A "Type 1" barricade with a flashing beacon or light is required to be placed at each end of the dumpster. See typical dumpster layout for reference.
- The minimum street width required to place a dumpster in the street is:
 - i. 36' (feet) if parking is allowed on both sides
 - ii. 32' (feet) if parking is allowed only on one side.
