## Background

#### • In June 2014,

**City of San Diego** 

- Huron Consulting Group
  - Reported to Council on its Competitive Initiatives Analysis
  - Recommended adding employee gain-sharing to complement other efficiency and competitiveness initiatives
- Mayor announced creation of San Diego Works

# **Administrative Regulation and Agreements**

• Administrative Regulation 95.93

**City of San Diego** 

- Created new AR to implement San Diego Works
- Conducted coalition bargaining with all six recognized employee organizations

#### Agreements

- Reached agreement with all six recognized employee organizations
- Seek Council approval of the six agreements



### San Diego Works Purpose

Purpose: San Diego Works is a pilot program to encourage collaboration within and between City departments and promote group ideas that generate savings and identify efficiencies and process improvements for the Fiscal Year 2016 budget.

# Timing

#### • For FY 2016 budget,

**City of San Diego** 

- Proposals accepted from 8/15/14 through 11/15/14
- Employees may request up to 5 hour release time to prepare proposals
- Award payments made in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter FY 2016
- For longer term ideas, same as above but
  - May make two award payments depending on
    - Implementation duration
    - Ability to include in FY 2017-2021 five year outlook

### **Administration**

### • Performance and Analytics Department administers

- Logs, reviews, and follows-up on proposals
- Validates savings calculations

**City of San Diego** 

- Convenes San Diego Works Review Committee to confirm recommendations, if necessary
- Ensures inclusion of successful proposals in FY2016 budget
- Follows through on making awards

### **Award Sources and Allocations**

Award Source	Award allocation
10% of idea's budgetary savings	paid to employees: maximum \$5,000 per employee and \$100,000 per group
10% of idea's budgetary savings	fund a pool used to pay for ideas that don't generate readily quantifiable savings
30% of idea's budgetary savings	go back to department for implementation expense and/or enhanced services
remainder	reinvested into neighborhood or other City services

Top Award: an additional one-time award to the single proposal team that offers the highest average annual savings above \$1M
