## USGA RULES APPLY UNLESS MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- PACE OF PLAY POLICY: For the enjoyment of all players, our pace of play policy is strictly enforced. All players are required to keep up with the group in front of them. Continuous putting is encouraged. Early morning players should play in 4 hours or less and midday or later players should play in 4 1/2 hours or less.
- Observe 90 degree cart rule, keep carts a minimum of 30 feet from greens and tees.
- Cooperate with Marshals at all times.
- ETIQUETTE: Repair all ball marks, replace all divots or fill with sand, and rake bunkers. No practicing is allowed on the course. Shirts are required at all times. Soft spikes are recommended.
- Out of Bounds is defined by all perimeter fences and/or white stakes.
- Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes. All canyons are considered lateral water hazards.
- Tee balls striking power lines on the fifth tee must re-tee with no penalty.
- Be aware of and do not feed native wildlife in the area (birds, squirrels, coyotes, etc.). US Department of Agriculture states feeding coyotes puts you, your fellow golfers and neighbors at risk.
- All players use the course at their own risk and are subject to all rules and regulations of the management. Park at your own risk. Do not leave clubs unattended. Management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
