

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course

Torrey Pines Golf Complex

- Strong reputation throughout the golfing world.
- Outstanding location and excellent course conditions.
- Rounds are down 12% from our targeted capacity due to the economy and to artificially restricting play from adhering to the 70% resident / 30% non-resident utilization requirement.
- Tournament facilities are limited.

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course

North Course

- Outstanding golf experience.
- In the past few years changes have been made to lengthen the golf course.
- The course has constraints and is limited in supporting today's demanding tournament requirements.
- The North Course has the longest yardage for women among the competition.
- On-course restrooms are in need of reconditioning.
- The course is without continuous cart paths.

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course

South Golf Course

- Internationally recognized as one of the finest municipal courses in the country.
- Prior to the 2008 US Open, significant improvements and upgrades were made to the course.
- The South Course is a long and demanding golf course.
- On-course restrooms are in need of reconditioning.

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course : Recommendations

Torrey Pines Complex

- Consider re-initiating a discussion regarding a tournament support building.
- Investigate developing unused areas of the facility for non-golf events and activities.
- Discuss market rates for commercial photo and film shoots.
- Establish target rounds for the Business Plan at 146,800; 82,800 for the North Course and 64,000 for the South Course.

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course : Recommendations

North Course

- Consider constructing continuous cart paths.
- Investigate remodeling the on-course restrooms.
- Evaluate the need for a new set of shorter Women's tees.
- Evaluate the course for general improvements that facilitate hosting competitive tournaments.

Facility Review Infrastructure / Course : Recommendations

South Course

- Continue to improve course conditioning as well as make improvements that facilitate daily play and hosting major golf events.
- Investigate course set-up options that would increase player enjoyment of the course.
- Investigate remodeling the on-course restrooms.
- Pursue major golf events that would continue to build on and sustain the South Course's local and international reputation.

Facility Review Marketing & Advertising – Recommendations

To maximize opportunities, we are recommending these ideas.

- Create a marketing staff position
- Utilize our customer database
- Develop an interactive website offering internet tee times
- Proactively solicit tournament play
- Revisit a Southern California rate
- Explore yield management techniques

Customer Satisfaction Survey – Recommendations

- Parking lot / arrival area Explore adding a bag drop / greeting area.
- Evaluate the training and effectiveness of the marshaling staff and volunteers.
- Review options to re-design the practice facilities.
- Discuss options to expand food & beverage service

Facility Review Rate Structure

- The staff feels that golf rates in general are in line at this time.
- We are recommending staying with the Resident Golf Card program.
- Consider updating the 70%/30% utilization to a tee time access percentage.
- Discuss releasing un-booked resident tee times.
- Examine the effects of adopting a super-twilight rate for the North course.
- Consider rates for special groups and tournaments.
- Establish rates for non-golf events.
- Discuss rates for Southern California residents.
