Session 1 through 7

Each week there will be up to 7 golf stations. Instructors will work to develop/refine each of the movements. There may be a different level of refinement as golfers progress through the camp as follows:

- **Game Management:**
 - Which includes lessons on the rules
 - Etiquette & Personnel conduct
 - How to manage a round of golf (Rolling (Putting), Chipping, Pitching, Launching, Life Skills)
 - Golf principals as it relates to the real world
 - What to expect at a golf course
 - How to use a golf course - Driving range, putting green, etc.
 - How to make tee times
 - How they can proceed to the next level

- **Play:** Set up a few holes and let them play the game

Session #8 (Last Thursday of each session we play real GOLF):

- 12:45 Leave with golfers to City Golf Course
- 1:15 Give golfers a tour of clubhouse
 - Talk about history of the City Golf Course
 - Talk about the history of the game or golf
 - Importance of the course and how it relates to life skills
- 1:30 Putting Contest
- 1:45 Golfers leaves the City Golf Course and return to their Recreation Center
