AIDS Walk San Diego 2013 Sunday, Sept. 30, 2013

“Street Challenge” Obstacle Course Route Proposal

As a way to generate additional revenue for the extremely deserving HIV/AIDS service providers that it benefits each year, AIDS Walk San Diego would like to include a “Street Challenge” obstacle course option for this year’s participants.

The “Street Challenge” obstacle course for **AIDS Walk San Diego 2013** will utilize the same footprint as our Walk Route. However, as opposed to utilizing 6th Avenue, Obstacle Course participants will be brought south on Balboa Drive and around Marston Point.

After the conclusion of the AIDS Walk Run, and after the “kick off” of the AIDS Walk San Diego Walk, groups of participants will be released in “heats” and go from Challenge to challenge trying to complete each one successfully.

Obstacles will be fabricated or rented. All elements will be free standing and weighted. To ensure the utmost safety of all participants, all obstacles are being vetted by our consultants from Renegade Racing—a production company that is a leader in running, triathlon and adventure sports events around Southern California

No water, mud, or sand will be used in any of the obstacles. The singular inflatable slide will be placed on a length of paved road or parking lot area around Marston Point.

All “obstacles” will be designed and installed in a way that will not harm or permanently impact Balboa Park’s natural beauty and resources in any way. All obstacles will be placed either on available concrete or “wood chipped” area.
