301. San Diego Science Festival, Science Expo – presented by Allison Rynne
Special Event proposal to use El Prado (from Lilly Pond to Cascades), Bea Evenson Fountain area, South Village Place, Botanical Building Lawns, and South Carousel Parking Lot on Saturday, April 4, 2009 to host a science exposition. Set up to begin on Friday, April 3 from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with the event on Saturday from 10:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Load out will conclude on Sunday, April 5 at 9:00 a.m. The event includes music acts, comedians, science based demonstrations and nationally renowned speakers.
