Changes to the marathon route in Mission Bay Park include the exclusive use of Fiesta Island. Impacts to other areas of Mission Bay Park are reduced with the course change.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: To approve the half marathon component and route change as presented. The addition of a half marathon has no additional impact to Mission Bay Park. The use of Fiesta Island results in less use to other areas in Mission Bay Park.
