HOURS OF OPERATION

Open: 6:30 a.m. daily.

Closed: 30 minutes before sunset (closing time displayed at all park entrances)

The park is closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

For the protection of all park visitors, Chollas Lake Park will be closed due to hazardous conditions such as:

- Rain • High winds • Lightning • Muddy trails • Other hazardous park conditions
- *The lake will remain closed after major rain storms until emergency vehicles can access all areas of the park.*

No swimming or wading is permitted.

Please leave only footprints and take only memories.

Pets must be kept on a leash and under control at all times.

Fires are permitted only in grills provided (no open fires).

Please do not harass or feed any wildlife.

Please help us keep our park clean and do not litter.

No throwing of sticks or rocks is allowed.

Please obey all City of San Diego and State Fish & Game regulations at all times.

Feel free to contact park staff with any questions you may have, or to report a violation.




CHOLLAS LAKE PARK
