Dear Mr. Gidofalvi:

I have enclosed Park and Recreation Board Policy No.1002, Gifts of Architectural Features, Works of Art and Commemorative Plaques for Public Parks or Other City Owned Land, and Council Policy 100-02, City Receipt Of Donations, per your request. You have indicated that the House of Hungary has expressed interest in the feasibility of recognizing the accomplishments and contributions of a deceased member of your community. These policies provide the framework for consideration by the City of San Diego. Should you wish to do so, this Issue would be presented to the Balboa Park Committee for their review and recommendation.

Additionally, we have reviewed your request to install a satellite dish at the House of Hungary. This installation is not consistent with the Balboa Park Central Mesa Precise Plan, Historic Preservation Standards. The U.S. Department of the Interior National Park Service has established guidelines for National Historic Landmark Zones. The Central Mesa is included in this Zone. As such, any rehabilitation and modification to architecture in the Central Mesa is accomplished in a manner, which preserves the historic and aesthetic significance while providing for functional needs.
