

Required Parks: 174 acres


## Uptown


# General Plan standards

1. Population-based park acreage: 2.8/1,000
2. Population-based Park Categories
  - Major Park; Community Park
  - Neighborhood Parks; Mini Parks; Pocket Parks/Plazas
  - Special Activity Parks
3. Equivalencies
  - Joint Use Facilities
  - Trails
  - Portions of Resource-based Parks
  - Privately-owned Park sites
  - Non-traditional Park sites
  - Facility or Building Expansion or Upgrade
