SUBJECT:

Canyonside Community Park General Development Plan (GDP) Amendment

SUMMARY

<u>Issue</u> – Should the Park and Recreation Board recommend approval of the proposed GDP amendment for Canyonside Community Park?

<u>Director's Recommendation</u> – Recommend approval of the proposed GDP Amendment for Canyonside Community Park.

<u>Other Recommendations</u> – The following groups have reviewed and considered the proposed project. Actions taken and recommendations made by these groups are listed under Discussion below.

Rancho Penasquitos Recreation Council

<u>Fiscal Impact</u> – No fiscal impact is associated with this action.

<u>Water and Energy Conservation Status</u> – The proposed amendment to the GDP for Carmel Valley Community Park complies with all water and energy conservation guidelines contained in Council Policy 200-14.

<u>Environmental</u> – This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section15303.

BACKGROUND

Canyonside Community Park, which was initially opened in 1993, is a43 acre population-based park located on Black Mountain Road in Rancho Penasquitos. The park currently includes a recreation center, tennis courts, playground, three multi-purpose athletic fields with eleven softball and baseball backstops, a cricket pitch, and horse shoe pitches. Canyonside Community Park is highly scheduled for active recreation leagues and tournaments. There are ten large tournaments held throughout the year. There are approximately 1,500 youths and 400 adults participating in sports organizations that use the park weekly.

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DISCUSSION

Due to heavy-use of the park year-round, the Rancho Penasquitos Recreation Council has discussed the option of adding additional parking to accommodate the hundreds of park visitors using the facility each day. Presently, there is not enough parking to meet the needs of the organized sports leagues, active tennis club, and general recreation center users.

The first step is to amend the park's General Development Plan (GDP) to include the new parking lot. If the proposed GDP amendment is approved, the design process will produce a site specific development plan including an analysis of parking needs and other site concerns such as accessibility for disabled park patrons. The design process will follow City Council Policy 600-33.

On July 28, 2011, the Rancho Penasquitos Recreation Council unanimously approved an action item to approve funds to hire a consultant to perform a study for a new parking lot on the northwest end of park.

On August 22, 2013, the Rancho Penasquitos Recreation Council discussed the proposed amendment and then unanimously approved the amendment of the existing GDP to include a new parking lot. This action provides a general master plan to include additional parking for the community park which currently doesn't have adequate parking to meet the needs of its users.

ALTERNATIVES

Approve the proposed GDP amendment for Canyonside Community Park with modifications.

Do not approve the proposed GDP amendment for Canyonside Community Park.


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
