The Subcommittee includes the following volunteers:




First meeting on March 12, 2010, followed by a site visit to each of the suggested sites on March 16, 2010.

The Subcommittee has identified seven sites.










LOOKING WEST




CORAL GATES RESIDENTIAL
COMMUNITY – ACROSS STREET













VIEW TOWARDS MEXICO FROM SCHOOL GROUNDS












