Tijuana River Valley Park Planning

Michael Freedman opened the meeting at 6:15 and turned it over to - Patrick McDonough, Sr. Project Mgr., County Dept. of Parks and Recreation. He provided an overview of park planning and existing and future recreational opportunities in the Tijuana River Valley including trails, passive and active recreational space. The community had a few questions which are reflected in the attached public comments.

Historic Context Presentation

Cathy Winterrowd, Principal Planner with the Historical and Natural Resources Section, City of San Diego, provided a synopsis of the historic resources and preservation information. The historic resource are mapped on the urban design map and the community was asked to comment on resources and the community wanted to discuss the old portion of San Ysidro in more detail as part of an urban design workshop.
