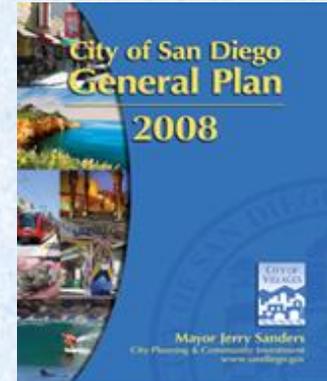

# WHAT WE DO

- ❑ Facilities Financing collects and administers Facilities Benefit Assessments (FBA) and Development Impact Fees (DIF)
- ❑ Prepare Public Facilities Financing Plans (PFFPs), which formulate the impact fees and are used to implement the infrastructure requirements as set forth in the community plans

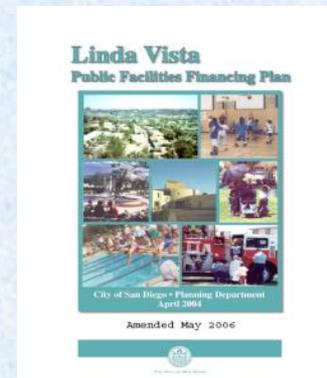

# Public Facilities Financing Plans (PFFPs)

- ❑ Implementation document for Community Plans
- ❑ Each plan includes:
  - Public Facilities Projects
  - Funding Sources for Public Facilities in PFFP
  - Schedule of Proposed FBA/DIF Fees
  - Cash Flow Analysis (FBAs only)
  - Assessment Roll of Liens (FBAs only)

## I. Planning Phase

- Call Letter to City Departments
- Review Community Plan
- Prepare Draft PFFP

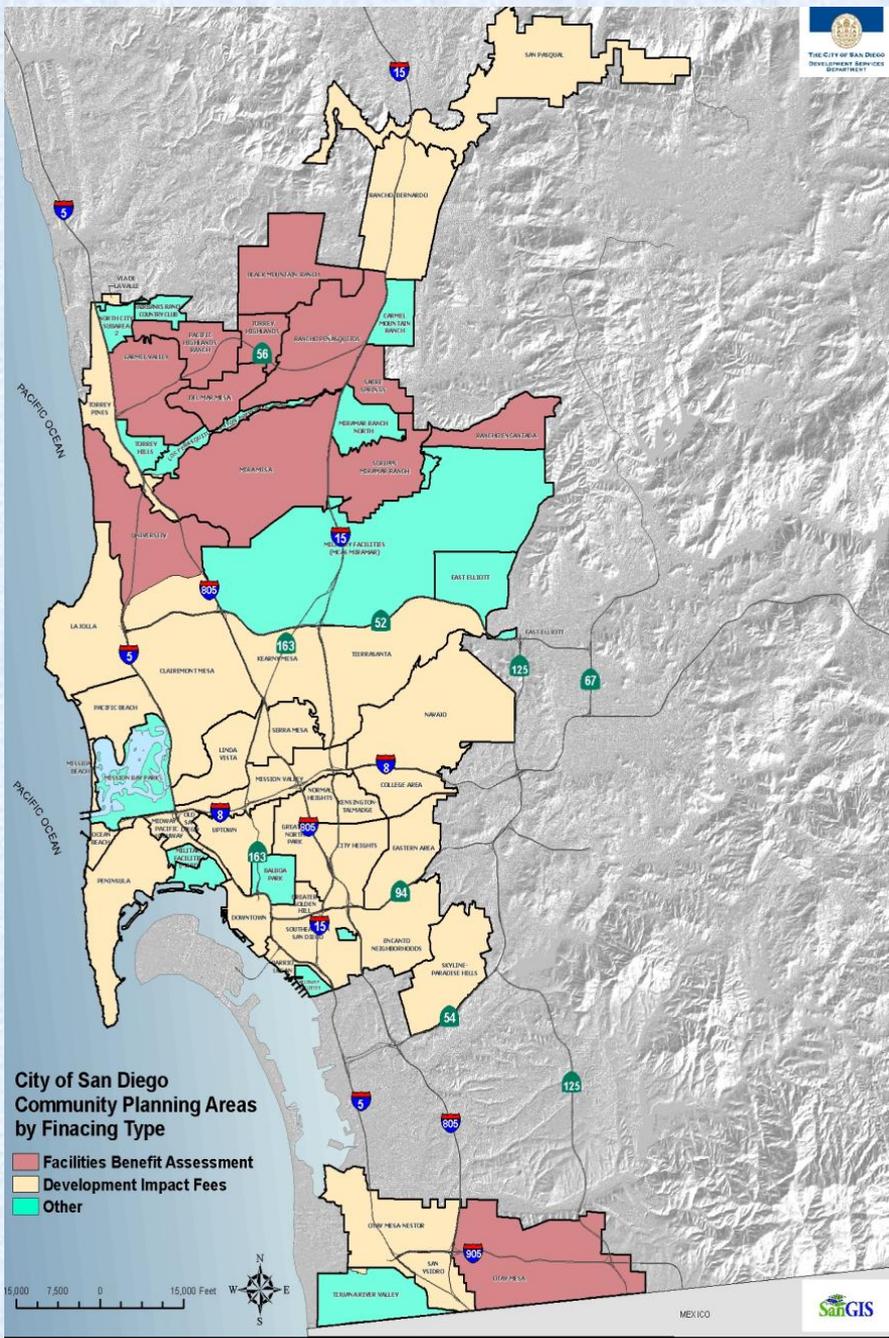
## II. Input Phase

- Submit Draft PFFP to Community Planning Groups

## III. Approval Phase

- Draft Document to LU&H & City Council for Approval

CA Government Code 66000  
(Mitigation Fee Act)

No Liens

Older Communities  
(In-fill development)

Fair Share Funding  
(Only a portion of cost)

Horizon Year  
(SANDAG forecasts)

Paid at Building Permit Issuance

# Qualifications for FBA/DIF Funding

- ❑ Must be in Community Plan
- ❑ Must be attributable to new development
- ❑ “Bricks and Mortar”
- ❑ No maintenance
- ❑ No operations

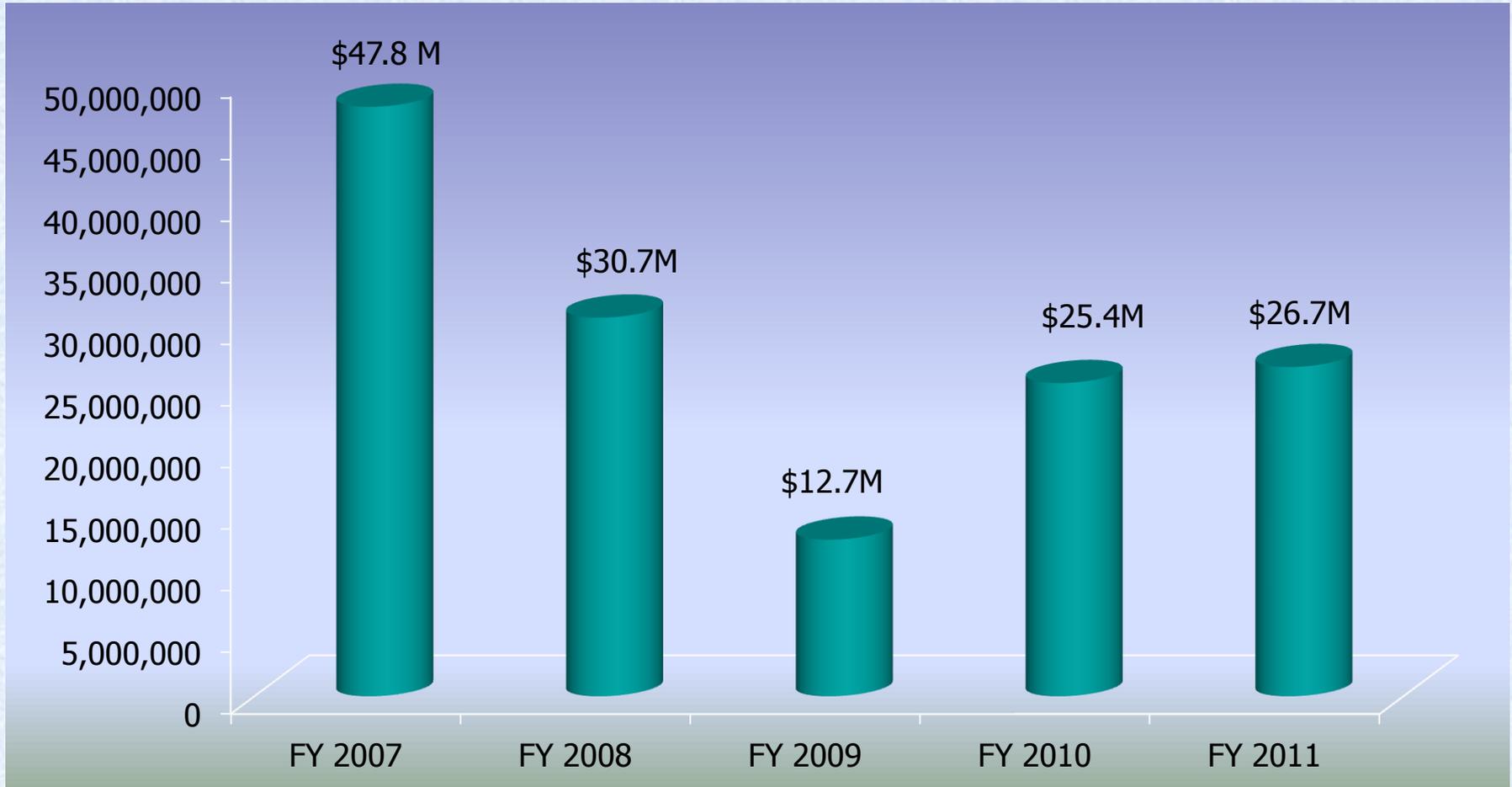

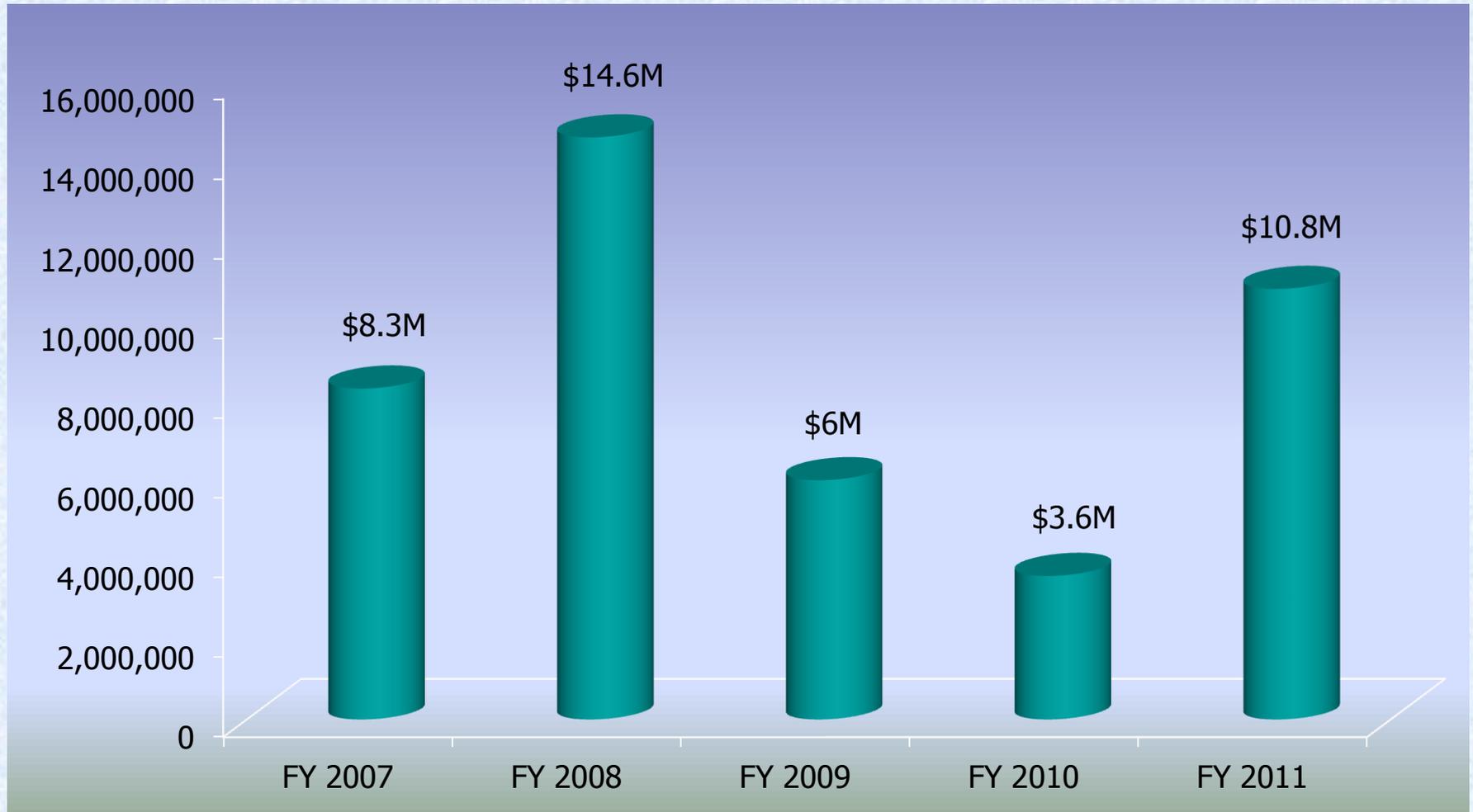
