### PLANNING DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Betsy McCullough briefly touched on the upcoming training sessions being present by Development Services Department and the Planning Department. **1. OVERSIZED AND NON-MOTORIZED VEHICLE PARKING ORDINANCE: Action item**

Debbie VanWanseele and Sam Hasenin presented a proposed draft ordinance on Prohibition of Parking of Oversized Vehicles and Non-Motorized Vehicles. **1)** Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles on any street for a period longer than four (4) hours. **2)** Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles on any street between the hours of 2 AM and 6 AM of any day. **3)** Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles within 50 feet of any intersection. **Motion:** Bring back to CPC in February. **Vote:** *unanimously*

**1. PLANNING GROUP INVOLVEMENT WITH THE DISABILITY COMMUNITY: Information item**

Linda Woodbury presented a great insight on people with disabilities. She explained how you focus on the people and their abilities, not their disabilities. The characteristic “disability” simple means utilize your abilities...just like the rest of society. Characteristics which we need to compensate for – overweight, shyness, fearful of rejection or loss of control, dependent, aggressive, too wealthy or too poor, sad or happy. We want to be accepted for our abilities, not rejected because of our disabilities.
