Main Issues

- **Excessive Speed** on Carmel Park Drive/Worsch Way
 - Speed Limit was raised to 30MPH, drivers are probably averaging at 40-45MPH.
- Drivers <u>Ignore Crosswalk</u> and Do <u>NOT</u> Stop
- **Passing with yellow line & crosswalk** on the left and right as vehicles turn west onto Santa Nella Place to drop kids off to CDM.
 - Accident in December nearly striking children
- Curve creates an **Unsafe Zone for Crossing**
 - 30 MPH = 44 Feet per Second
 - 45 MPH = 66 Feet per Second
 - o 14-22 Yards per Second
