Golden Hill Fountain

Volunteer Restoration Project

Phase 1

- Clean all graffiti from rocks and grout
- Clean soot and fire damage from fountain basin
- Dig out accumulated dirt on terrace and stairs
- Unearth existing steps, drains, and terrace floor
- Replace keystone feature at base of staircases
- Replace stone basin feature opposite the fountain
- Replace missing stones (search canyon for original stones)
- Restore stone bench supports, rebuild wood benches with center arm rail
- Replace missing stones to redefine/restore pathways
- Plant garden behind fountain with drought tolerant plants
- Install irrigation
- Install signage at entrance to stone bordered path describing the Golden Hill Fountain history

Phase 2

- Restore fountain to working condition, recirculation pumps, power for pumps
- Plant extended area gardens with drought tolerant plants
- Install irrigation
- Install path lighting (consider solar)
