Re Agenda Item IV.A.: Letter from City of SD Transportation & Storm Water Dept.:

This is regarding a proposal to install head-in parking on the east side of Alabama Street between Polk Avenue and Lincoln Avenue. Based on the street width and number of driveways, the east side of Alabama Street is best suited for head-in parking. Our evaluation determined that we will gain a total of 23 additional parking spaces by installing head-in parking at this location.

The residents have signed the petition with 81% in favor of the proposed head in parking. It is our practice to seek input from community planning groups prior to making a final decision on head-in parking. Please review this location for the proposed head-in parking and provide a recommendation from your group within 30 days. If you have any questions regarding this
