The Meeting was brought to order at 12:05 PM by Jeff Sallen, Chairman of the Kearny Mesa Planning Group who acted as the Chair of the Meeting. Copies of the Minutes of the September 17, 2014 meeting were distributed and discussed. After the members reviewed the minutes, Jeff asked for any changes or corrections. There were none. Upon a motion and seconded, those minutes of the May meeting were approved as presented (11-0-0)

The Chair continued the meeting by asking for public comment. Scott Chipman, a business owner and resident of Pacific Beach spoke in front of the group in regards to his beliefs pertaining to the Medical marijuana Consumer Cooperatives seeking Conditional Use Permits in District 6. Following Scott, Kathy Lippitt also spoke in front of the group regarding the same subject.

Jeff then proceeded to move on to mail and other items received since the previous meeting.

Moving on to Action Items, Skyler Denniston with Kaiser Medical Center gave a detailed presentation on the future signage planned for the medical center in Kearny Mesa (corner of Ruffin Road and Clairemont Mesa Blvd). Instead of voting on the sign descriptions prevented, the Kearny Mesa Planning Board requested that Skyler return to the meeting next month with a more detailed plan and drawing. Kaisers proposed signage will require a Neighborhood Use Permit since the proposed signage falls outside of the allowed sign criteria.

Following Skyler's presentation, there were no additional action items to discuss and Jeff asked for any members from government to speak. Allen Young (council representative for Chris Cate) introduced himself and discussed some of the initiatives that Cate plans to see through as Council Member for District 6.
