The Meeting was brought to order at 12:10 PM by Jeffrey Sallen, Chair of the Kearny Mesa Planning Group. Copies of the Minutes of the June 17, 2015 meeting were distributed and discussed. After the members reviewed the minutes, Jeff asked for any changes or corrections. There were no changes. Upon a motion and a seconded, those minutes of the June meeting were approved (8-0-0).

Jeff then asked Kearny Mesa Planning Group Member Ed Quinn to speak to the group in regards to his experience representing the Kearny Mesa Planning Group at the Planning Commission. Ed's experience with the Planning Commission was not positive and reflected the Kearny Mesa Planning Groups lack of voting power in the community.

The meeting was then opened to Public Comment. There was none at this time.

Following the public comment, agenda item #4, was presented by Sergeant Robert Stinson in regards to an application for a liquor license at 8690 Aero Drive, Suite 101 (Mazzika Hookah Lounge). The planning group voted in favor of the license (9-0-0).

Following agenda item #4, a Bruce Jordan, CEO of Jordan Architects, Inc. presented a 3-story above basement level Self Storage Building which requires a Planned Development Permit. The subject site is located at 9645 Aero Drive. The permit was approved by the planning group (9-0-0).

Following agenda item #5, Jeff asked if any city or government officials were in the audience and would like to speak. Anthony George, Howard Ou and Allen Young all stood and spoke for a few minutes each updating the group on The San Diego Charges Stadium as well as the future Kearny Mesa Community Plan Update.
