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## Minutes of the April 22, 2013 Meeting

Meeting opened at 5:39pm by Tom Cleary, Chair. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Gail Cole.

Members present: Doug Beckham, Lauree Camarato, Jo-Ann Carini, Margarita Castro, Tom Cleary, Gail Cole, Sandy Duncan, Dorothy Perez, Jeff Perwin, Tisha Rocha, and Dixie Wilson. Keith Warner added under Action Item #1. (12)

Members absent: Drew Corley, Kathleen Morgen, Ralph Perez, Kim Shannon, Ron Tomcek, Vicki Van Dyk, and 4 vacancies.

12 members present. 10 visitors present. Total in attendance: 22

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Motion by Duncan to approve the April 22, 2013 agenda, including tabling of Action Item #2 on election of officers to next month, seconded by Beckham. Agenda approved 10-0.

Motion by Wilson to approve March 25, 2013 meeting minutes, seconded by Beckham. Vote: 10-0. February minutes approved.

### **Reports by Government Representatives:**

- Congress: Gavin Deeb for Rep. Susan Davis reported on followed-up to concerns about the unkempt appearance of the local post office, provided copies of the Davis Dispatch, announced forums will be held on grant writing 5/2/13 and scams targeting senior citizens 4/30/13.
- State Legislature: Joyce Temporal introduced herself and talked about legislation introduced and championed by Sen. Marty Block and invited all to district office open house on April 25.
- City: Ian Clampett of Councilman Faulconer's office discussed Kevin's 'state of the district address,' support of community review of any medical marijuana ordinance, pothole hotline and audit of the pothole program and how infrastructure is still a budget priority.
- Tom Knepper of Councilman Sherman's office reported \$11,000 cost summer learn-to-swim pool at LV Rec Center (7/29-8/16) will be funded out of their district office. Medical marijuana ordinance will be sent to community planning groups for review.
- SDPD: Officer Surwillo recapped that LV's Doug Beckham was honored at SDPD's Volunteer Recognition Day and Capt. Mills held a community walk thru in LV on April 18<sup>th</sup>.

### **Announcements & Public Comment on Non-Agenda Items:**

- Oscar Marin (Jr. and Sr.): announced their new coffee lounge at LV Road & Glidden is open and invited community members to stop by.
- Janet Kaye: reminded all the Linda Vista Multicultural Fair & Parade will be April 27<sup>th</sup>
- Hanna Kite: childhood obesity initiative will be discussed at LV Collaborative
- Jo-Ann Carini: Parade of Flags will be conducted on May 27, Memorial Day. Volunteers are always welcome and needed.

### **Chairman's Report:**

- Tom Cleary attended Kevin Faulconer's state of the district address on April 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Action Items:**

- 1) **Appointment of Keith Warner** by acclamation to vacant seat in CT 88 (at-large) under Article IV, Sec. 2.
- 2) **Election of Officers:** item tabled to May meeting.
- 3) **Sprint South Linda Vista (Project #306861):** presentation by Jin Park on CUP, Process 4 permit for a wireless communication facility consisting of 9 panel antennas mounted on a roof of an existing building at 2125 Westinghouse (zoned RM-3-7). Motion by Wilson, seconded by Castro. Approved 10-0 (with Beckham recusing himself).
- 4) **Renewal of LVPG Post Office Box:** A \$78 fee is needed for the next 12 months. Funds are from contributions donated to LVPG. Motion by Wilson, seconded by Rocha. Approved 11-0.
- 5) **Letter of support for a skateboard park in Linda Vista:** Chair to write letter to Park & Rec supporting need and concept for skateboard park. Motion by Wilson, seconded by D. Perez. Approved 11-0.
- 6) **Webpage upgrade:** Jeff Perwin to provide a briefing on necessary changes for the LVPG webpage and \$50 site license will be needed to go live with new webpage. Motion by Wilson to expend the funds, seconded by D. Perez. Approved 10-0 (with Perwin recusing himself).

**Note:** The chair doesn't vote, except in cases of a tie.

**Committee Reports & Updates:**

- **Code Compliance Committee** – Jo-Ann Carini reported their first meeting was held in March and will hold future meetings on first Wednesday of the month.
- **Linda Vista Recreation Council** – Doug Beckham reported the new picnic shelter should be complete by June.
- **Linda Vista Town Council** – Dottie Perez reported the damaged community entry sign on Genesee near Osler was picked up to be repaired.

**Treasurer Report:**

\$8.25 was collected at this night's meeting. Balance is now \$456.07
