ITEM #8 MEDICAL MARIJUANA TASK FORCE (LAND USE) RECOMMENDATIONS VOTING ITEM Ellen Willis, Board Chair presenting

At the request of the City Council, the RBCPB will address the (land use) recommendations from the Medical Marijuana Task Force:

- <u>Permitting Process</u>: Cooperatives/collectives with <100 members would require a Process 2 permit; more than 100 members would require a Process 3 permit
- <u>Permit Renewals</u>: Follow process outlined in Chapter 12, Article 6, division 3 of Municipal Code
- <u>Zoning (by permit</u>): Commercial-Regional(CR); Commercial Office (CO); Commercial – Community (CC); Commercial – (CN): Commercial – Visitor (CV); Industrial – Park (IP); Industrial – Light (IL); Industrial – Heavy (IH)

- <u>Distance Requirements</u>: shall <u>not</u> be located: (a) within a 1,000-foot radius of schools, playgrounds, libraries, child care facilities, youth facilities...and not (b) within a 500 foot radius of other /same uses.
- <u>Not for Profit Operation</u>: (status) requirement as part of their application for a conditional use permit
- <u>Security</u>: requires adequate and operable security system to include cameras, alarms and guard during business hours
- <u>Lighting</u>: lighting shall be hooded or oriented to deflect away from adjacent properties. shall illuminate the dispensing cooperative/collective in immediate surrounding area; storage, parking, front facade, adjoining sidewalk.
- Hours of Operation: 7:00 am to 9:00 PM seven days a week
- <u>Signage:</u> (a) all signage shall comply with Chapter 14 Article 2 Div 12 of the Municipal Code (b) limited to name of establishment and design limited to two colors (c) dispensaries shall display on wall or identification sign name, emergency contact, phone # of operator/manager in 2" high letters (d) dispensaries shall post indoor sign containing warnings (i) that diversion of marijuana for non-medical purpose is a violation of state law; (ii) that the use of medical marijuana may impair a person's ability to drive a motor vehicle/operate machinery, and (iii) that loitering on and around the dispensary site is prohibited by CA Penal Code Section 647 (e)
